Thereafter, a late payment fee of \$195 will be assessed. **Imagine** reserves the right to add a surcharge if the dollar declines by more than 2% against the Israel Shekel and/or Euro based on foreign exchange rates in effect on January 25, 2011. **All prices are in US Dollars.**

ACCOMMODATIONS: Price is based on double occupancy. When available, single rooms/cabins are often smaller than doubles. While **Imagine** will try to match roommates, we cannot guarantee one will be available. Roommates may be assigned as late as 35 days prior to departure and, if one is not available or if you request a single, the following **single charges apply: \$571** basic itinerary.

DAY 01 – Nov. 14, DEPART FOR TEL AVIV

Tour members depart for our flight from Vancouver, we will change planes enroute for our flight to Tel Aviv, Israel. After take-off to Israel, we will be served dinner.

DAY 02 – Nov. 15, TEL AVIV, DEAD SEA

We arrive in Tel Aviv mid afternoon, upon arrival we are met by our agent who assists us through customs and security. We are then transferred to our motor coach for our drive to the Dead Sea, Ein Bokek Area. We drive through the Judean Wilderness with a descent of approximately 3000+ feet, to what is often referred to as the lowest spot on earth. Welcome dinner and opportunity for a swim and overnight at our Dead Sea Gardens Hotel.

DAY 03 — Nov. 16, DEAD SEA, MASADA, EIN GEDI, QUMRAN, GIDEON SPRINGS, GALILEE

After a refreshing swim, enjoy a relaxing breakfast before we start our day's sightseeing. Our first stop will be a visit to Masada, where we will ascend high upon the wilderness mountain by way of cable car to the fortress build by King Herod. Here we will survey the ruins of the fortifications, waterworks, synagogue, temples and palaces.

After a quick snack and drink, it is a short drive to Ein Gedi, where David hid from King Saul. It is here we will hike the rocky path to one of the beautiful spots in the region. Once we have finished lunch at Ein Gedi we follow the road north along the Dead Sea and we travel to Qumran, where the Dead Sea Scrolls were discovered.

There will be opportunity to see the cave where the Dead Sea Scrolls were found. From there we make our way to the Galilee, with our last sightseeing stop at Gideon Springs (Judges 7) there is a famous account where Gideon brought the army of Israel to this spring to select warriors who would join him in battle. We will have dinner and spend that night in Tiberias at the Leonardo Hotel, Tiberias.

DAY 04 – Nov. 17, GALILEE, JESUS BOAT, BOAT RIDE ON SEA OF GALILEE, CAPERNAUM, MT. OF BEATITUDES

There is nothing quite like watching a sunrise on the Sea of Galilee from your hotel. We begin our day with a boat ride on the Sea of Galilee and then a special visit to the 2000-year-old replica Jesus Boat that dates back to the time of Christ. Today will include many biblical sites along the shore of the Sea of Galilee which includes Capernaum (Matt. 4:13) and Mount of Beatitudes (Matt. 5-7). Dinner and then enjoy the sunset with worship in Tiberias.

DAY 05 – Nov. 18, CAESAREA PHILIPPI, GOLAN HEIGHTS, NAOT FACTORY, AND TEL DAN

After breakfast we begin our travels to view Mt. Hermon (Deut. 3:8), and Hazor (Josh 11:10; 1 Kgs. 9:15) make a short drive to the Golan Heights area to see the Good Fence, and we can view Lebanon from a distance. Here we will continue to visit the Naot factory. We then will drive north to Caesarea Philippi (Banias; Mark 8:27) where we will have an opportunity to see the location where Jesus spoke to his disciples and asked them "who do you say that I am?" We will then continue on to Tel Dan and then return back to our hotel in the Galilee for dinner and overnight.

DAY 06 – Nov. 19, NAZARETH, KFAR KEDEM, MEGIDDO, MT. CARMEL, JERUSALEM

Today we depart for Galilee, visiting the following biblical sites: Nazareth-visit the Synagogue Church (Luke 1 & 2), Kfar Kedem Experience, then on to Megiddo (Armageddon; 1 Kgs. 9:15; Rev. 16:16) - we'll stop at Druze Village in time for lunch and shopping, then it will be onto Mt. Carmel (1 Kgs. 18). Then it will be onto Jerusalem for Dinner and over-night at the Grand Court Hotel (which is walking distance to the Old City).

DAY 07 – Nov. 20, MT. OF OLIVES, GARDEN OF GETHSEMANE, TEMPLE MOUNT, VIA DOLOROSA, RABBINICAL TUNNEL

We begin our explorations with a drive to the beautiful Mt. of Olives to behold the breath-taking panorama of the Holy City. Our pilgrimage will proceed to Dominus Flevit, then onto Gethsemane with its ancient olive grove, and there visit the Church of Agony, where tradition holds that Jesus prayed. We will enter Jerusalem through the Dung Gate, and walk to the holiest site in the whole Jewish world, the Western Wall (Wailing Wall) of Herod's temple. Beyond the wall lies the 35-acre temple area purchased by King David (2 Sam. 24:18-25).

On this site now stands the Dome of the Rock (the third holiest shrine in all Islam) and view the El-Aksa Mosque. From the temple area, we make our way to the Rabbinical Tunnel and then St. Anne's Crusader Church, Pools of Bethesda, the Sister of Zion Convent (to see the Pavement where Jesus stood as he was being tried by Pilate), Ecco Homo Arch, and then follow the Via Dolorosa for a short visit to the Church of the Holy Sepulchre and the ancient Cardo. Dinner and overnight in Jerusalem.

DAY 08 – Nov. 21, DAVIDSON CENTER, SOUTHERN STEPS, CITY OF DAVID, YAD VASHEM, GARDEN TOMB

We begin the day with a special visit to the new Davidson Center and Southern Steps (the actual steps that Jesus would have walked up to the Temple Mount). Then we will go to recently excavated City of David visit, afterwards we drive to St. Peter Gallicantu. From there we will go to Yad Vashem Holocaust Memorial and will have lunch. Late in the afternoon we will visit the Garden Tomb for a special Communion Service. Dinner and overnight in Jerusalem.

DAY 9 – Nov. 22, JERUSALEM, FULL DAY SIGHTSEEING

Today's sightseeing is to be determined by your tour leader and tour guide, to visit places additional sites throughout Jerusalem, IE: Hezekiah's

Tunnel, Temple Institute, etc. Dinner and overnight in Jerusalem.

DAY 10 – Nov. 23, JERUSALEM, OPTIONAL VISIT TO BETHLEHEM OR DAY WITHOUT PLANNED ACTIVITIES

Today is without a planned program with the exception of doing Bethlehem first thing in the morning. From there you will have time to explore Jerusalem on your own or revisit the places of most interest: Jerusalem ramparts, Israel Museum & the Shrine of the Book where the Dead Sea Scrolls are displayed, Herodian. Your tour guide will be able to provide you with some suggestions on arrangements for you to explore and visit these sites on your own. Dinner and overnight in Jerusalem.

DAY 11—Nov. 24, YAD HASHMONA, CAESAREA MARITIMA, TEL AVIV

After a leisurely breakfast we begin our day of sight-seeing with a visit to Yad Hashmona for a visit to the Biblical Village with a detailed explanation. After-wards we begin our drive towards the west coast of Israel for the Mediterranean Sea. We arrive at Caesarea Maritima (Acts 9 & 25), where we will have ample time to see this incredible excavated city, aqueducts, theatre and much more. Dinner and overnight in Tel Aviv area at Grand Beach Hotel, which is located a half-block from the beach and Mediterranean Sea.

DAY 12 – Nov. 25, TEL AVIV, USA

Early morning transfer to Ben Gurion Airport for our return flight back home. We arrive back in Vancouver the same day.
