Background, History and Purpose

'True education doesn't come from the wisdom of the world, but by the guidance and the wisdom that comes from the Holy Spirit.' (Pastor Chuck Smith, Calvary Chapel Distinctives).

Early in 2023, RCC formed the Riverside Education Society (RES) in a desire to bring cohesiveness between home, school, and church by empowering parents to be the main oversight of their children's education. With a larger number of RCC families turning to homeschooling, Riverside Christian Academy (RCA) was formed to provide home learners with a supplemental Bible focused ministry two mornings per week including Chapel and weekly activities.

Knowing our short weekly Bible classes and Chapels only met a small percentage of families desiring to have their children taught with an accurate Biblical Worldview, we prayerfully considered opening a full day program for families unable to provide home learning. Recognizing such a program would mean running instruction during a parent's working hours and/or school hours, meant that we would prayerfully consider applying for Group 3 Independent school certification.

Our purpose is unlike other schools in our area, and we believe, is one of a kind. RCA is a blend of home, church, and school. We structure our classes like a One Room Schoolhouse where younger generations learn from those who are older, be it a teacher/facilitator, a classroom parent, or an older student. We learn from each other, encourage each other, and use the Bible as the basis for all our curriculum, lessons, and activities.

Statement of Faith

Riverside Christian Academy's Statement of Faith directly flows from the beliefs of Riverside Calvary Chapel and the Calvary Chapel Movement. Please read through in completion and pursue with the application if you are in agreement with all of the statements.

WE BELIEVE that there is one living and true GOD, eternally existing in three persons: The Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit, equal in power and glory; that this triune God created all, upholds all, and governs all. (Genesis 1:1; Deuteronomy 6:4; Matthew 28:19; John 10:30; Hebrews 9:14; 1 John 5:7)

WE BELIEVE that the SCRIPTURES of the Old and New Testaments are the Word of God, fully inspired without error and the infallible rule of faith and practice. The Word of God is the foundation upon which this church operates and is the basis for which this church is governed. We believe that the Word of God supersedes any earthly law that is contrary to the Holy Scriptures. (Isaiah 28:13; Nehemiah 8:8; John 17:17; 2 Timothy 3:16-17; Hebrews 4:12; 1 Peter 1:23-25; 2 Peter 1:21)

WE BELIEVE in GOD THE FATHER, an infinite, personal Spirit, perfect in holiness, wisdom, power and love; that He concerns Himself in the affairs of men; that He hears and answers prayer; and that He saves from sin and death all who come to Him through Jesus Christ. (Deuteronomy 33:27; Psalms 90:2; Psalms 102:27; John 4:24; 1 Timothy 1:17; Titus 1:3)

WE BELIEVE in JESUS CHRIST, God's only begotten Son, begotten not made, conceived by the Holy Spirit. We believe in His virgin birth, sinless life, miracles and teachings, His substitutionary atoning death, bodily resurrection, ascension into heaven, perpetual intercession for His people and personal, visible return to earth. (Isaiah 7:14; Micah 5:2; Matthew 1:23; Mark 16:19; Luke 1:34-35; John 1:1-2; John 8:58; John 11:25; 1 Corinthians 15:3-4; Hebrews 1:8; 1 John 1:2; Revelation 1:8)

WE BELIEVE in the HOLY SPIRIT, Who came forth from the Father and the Son to convict the world of sin, righteousness, and judgment, and to regenerate, sanctify and empower for ministry all who believe in Jesus Christ; (Acts 1:8; 2 Corinthians 3:18; John 16:8-11; Romans 15:13,16; Hebrews 9:14)

WE BELIEVE the Holy Spirit indwells every believer in Jesus Christ and that He is an abiding Helper, Teacher, and Guide. (John 14:16-17, 16:8-11)

WE BELIEVE in the present ministry of the Holy Spirit and in the exercise of all the Biblical gifts of the Spirit. (Romans 12, 1 Corinthians 12 & 14)

WE BELIEVE that all PEOPLE are sinners by nature and choice and, therefore, are under condemnation; that God regenerates by the Holy Spirit, those who repent of their sins and confess Jesus Christ as Lord; that Jesus Christ baptizes the seeking believer with the Holy Spirit and power for service, often subsequent to regeneration. (Acts 8:15-17; Titus 3:5)

WE BELIEVE in the universal CHURCH, the living spiritual body, of which Jesus Christ is the Head and all regenerated persons are members. (1 Corinthians 12:12-13; Ephesians 4:15-16)

WE BELIEVE that the Lord Jesus Christ committed two ORDINANCES to the Church: 1) baptism, and 2) the Lord's Supper. We believe in baptism by immersion and communion open to all.(Matt. 28:19; Acts 2:38; 1 Corinthians 11:23-26)

WE BELIEVE that the institution of marriage is ordained of God, that it is a holy ordinance which serves as a model of the relationship between our Lord Jesus Christ and His bride, the church as described in the Bible. Furthermore, we believe that marriage is exclusively the legal union of one man with one woman. (Genesis 2:18-24, Matthew 19:5, 1 Corinthians 7:2)

WE BELIEVE also in the LAYING ON OF HANDS for the baptism of the Holy Spirit for ordination of pastors, elders, and deacons, and for receiving the perpetuity of the gifts of the Holy Spirit. (Acts 6:6, 8:17; 1 Timothy 4:14)

WE BELIEVE in the personal, visible RETURN OF CHRIST to earth and the establishment of His Kingdom, in the resurrection of the body, the final judgment and eternal blessing of the righteous and endless suffering of the wicked. (Matthew 16:27; Acts 1:11; Revelation 19:11-16, 20: 11-15)

WE BELIEVE in a literal Heaven and a literal Hell and that all those who place their faith, hope and trust in Jesus Christ will spend eternity in Heaven with the Lord, while those who reject Jesus' free gift of salvation will spend eternity separated from the Lord in Hell. (Matthew 5:3, 25:31-34; Hebrews 12:23; 1 Peter 1:4; Psalm 9:17; Matthew 5:22, 18:9; Luke 12:5)

WE BELIEVE in the Pre-Tribulation Rapture of the Church where all believers will meet the Lord in the air and be taken out of this world prior to the Tribulation that will come upon the earth. (Matthew 24:29-31; Luke 21:36; Romans 1:18, 5:9; 1 Thessalonians 5:9; 2 Peter 2:7-9; Revelation 5:7-10, 7:13-14; Zephaniah 2:1-3)

Job Summary:

The primary focus of Riverside Christian Academy's Level 2 Teacher is to oversee the discipleship, classroom management and instruction of Level 2 Learners. Teachers at RCA will lead, guide and mentor the students, parents and volunteers within their class. Working in partnership with the school Principal of RCA and each student's parents/guardians, a Level 2 Teacher will disciple their students in Christ through the deep exploration and study of God's Word, Mathematics, English Language Arts, Science, Socials, and Fine Arts.

Responsibilities, Duties and Expectations:

Classroom Leadership:

- Pray, plan, and advocate for the development of children within their classroom through spiritual, cognitive, emotional, physical, creative and social development.
- o Provide excellent instruction and assessment to facilitate student learning.
- o Collaborate with RCA Principal to invite, train, and equip parents and volunteers to educate students in Biblical truth throughout all curricular areas.
- Ensure that the relationship between church, home and school is established so that quality Biblical education is implemented and maintained.

Communication:

- Maintain clear channels of communication with the RCA Principal and inform them of needs, activities, and/or problems
- Receive the principal's input and insight related to classroom management and delivery of curriculum.
- Maintain consistent channels of communication with parents.

Safety & Operation:

- Create a family-friendly environment that provides safety and security for students and their families to maintain a positive partnership.
- Maintain a safe environment for all staff, students, parents and volunteers.
- o Practice Emergency Procedures regularly and keep consistent record practice initiatives.



Administration:

- Ensure that policies and procedures are followed in the classroom to uphold Riverside Calvary Chapel's (RCC) doctrines and values.
- Research and/or assist in the development of theologically/biblically aligned and developmentally appropriate curriculum that supports the growth of students/families.
- o Understand and implement the requirements set out by the RES and RCC.
