Which Came First?

Cast: John, Ashley, Dylan

Props: Hard-boiled egg

DYLAN *is looking at a hard-boiled egg, and he appears perplexed.* **JOHN** and **ASHLEY** enter.

JOHN: What's wrong, Dylan?

ASHLEY: Yeah, you look confused.
