

Bible Drill Scripture Sheet

Have students close their Bibles and place them on the table in front of them. Say each verse reference only. You should say something like, "Isaiah 54:9—Go!" The students may then start flipping through their Bible, racing to see if they can find the passage first. When they have found it, they are to put their finger on the verse and stand up. After all are standing, the winner reads the verse. You must verify the verse, making sure it's the right one. Repeat these directions with each of the verses below. Encourage students to use their Table of Contents if needed. Praise all the students who are able to find the verse.

1. Isaiah 54:9 For this is like the waters of Noah to Me; for as I have sworn that the waters of Noah would no longer cover the earth, so have I sworn that I would not be angry with you, nor rebuke you.
2. Ezekiel 14:14 "Even if these three men, Noah, Daniel, and Job, were in it, they would deliver only themselves by their righteousness," says the Lord God.
3. Matthew 24:37–39 ³⁷ But as the days of Noah were, so also will the coming of the Son of Man be. ³⁸ For as in the days before the flood, they were eating and drinking, marrying and giving in marriage, until the day that Noah entered the ark, ³⁹ and did not know until the flood came and took them all away, so also will the coming of the Son of Man be.
4. Hebrews 11:7 By faith Noah, being divinely warned of things not yet seen, moved with godly fear, prepared an ark for the saving of his household, by which he condemned the world and became heir of the righteousness which is according to faith.
5. 2 Peter 2:5 [God] did not spare the ancient world, but saved Noah, one of eight people, a preacher of righteousness, bringing in the flood on the world of the ungodly.
