## LESSON 8

### Ruth 1:16

<sup>16</sup> But Ruth said [to Naomi]: "Entreat me not to leave you, Or to turn back from following after you; For wherever you go, I will go; And wherever you lodge, I will lodge; Your people shall be my people, And your God, my God."

### Ruth 2:11

<sup>11</sup> And Boaz answered and said to her, "It has been fully reported to me, all that you have done for your mother-in-law since the death of your husband, and how you have left your father and your mother and the land of your birth, and have come to a people whom you did not know before."

### Ruth 4:13

<sup>13</sup> So Boaz took Ruth and she became his wife.

## LESSON 9

### 1 Samuel 2:23

<sup>23</sup> So [Eli] said to [his sons], "Why do you do such things? For I hear of your evil dealings from all the people."

### 1 Samuel 3:6–8a, 3:10, 3:13

<sup>6</sup> Then the Lord called yet again, "Samuel!" So Samuel arose and went to Eli, and said, "Here I am, for you called me." He answered, "I did not call, my son; lie down again." <sup>7</sup> (Now Samuel did not yet know the Lord, nor was the word of the Lord yet revealed to him.) <sup>8</sup> And the Lord called Samuel again the third time.

<sup>10</sup> Now the Lord came and stood and called as at other times, "Samuel! Samuel!" And Samuel answered, "Speak, for Your servant hears."

<sup>13</sup> "For I have told [Eli] that I will judge his house forever for the iniquity which he knows, because his sons made themselves vile, and he did not restrain them."

### 1 Samuel 4:10–11

<sup>10</sup> So the Philistines fought, and Israel was defeated, and every man fled to his tent. There was a very great slaughter, and there fell of Israel thirty thousand foot soldiers. <sup>11</sup> Also the ark of God was captured; and the two sons of Eli, Hophni and Phinehas, died.

## LESSON 10

### 1 Samuel 8:6–7, 8:11, 8:19–20

<sup>6</sup> "Give us a king to judge us." So Samuel prayed to the Lord. <sup>7</sup> And the Lord said to Samuel, "Heed the voice of the people in all that they say to you; for they have not rejected you, but they have rejected Me, that I should not reign over them."

<sup>11</sup> And he said, "This will be the behavior of the king who will reign over you: He will take your sons and appoint them for his own chariots and to be his horse-men, and some will run before his chariots."

<sup>19</sup> Nevertheless the people refused to obey the voice of Samuel; and they said, "No, but we will have a king over us, <sup>20</sup> that we also may be like all the nations, and that our king may judge us and go out before us and fight our battles."

### 1 John 2:15

<sup>15</sup> Do not love the world or the things in the world. If anyone loves the world, the love of the Father is not in him.

### 1 Samuel 10:24

<sup>24</sup> "Do you see him [Saul] whom the Lord has chosen, that there is no one like him among all the people?" So all the people shouted and said, "Long live the king!"

## LESSON 11

### 1 Samuel 13:8–9

<sup>8</sup> Then he [Saul] waited seven days, according to the time set by Samuel. But Samuel did not come to Gilgal; and the people were scattered from him.

<sup>9</sup> So Saul said, “Bring a burnt offering and peace offerings here to me.” And he offered the burnt offering.

### 1 Samuel 15:7, 15:9

<sup>7</sup> And Saul attacked the Amalekites, from Havilah all the way to Shur, which is east of Egypt.

<sup>9</sup> But Saul and the people spared Agag and the best of the sheep, the oxen, the fatlings, the lambs, and all that was good, and were unwilling to utterly destroy them. But everything despised and worthless, that they utterly destroyed.

## LESSON 12

### 1 Samuel 16:7, 16:13, 16:18

<sup>7</sup> But the Lord said to Samuel, “Do not look at his appearance or at his physical stature, because I have refused him. For the Lord does not see as man sees; for man looks at the outward appearance, but the Lord looks at the heart.”

<sup>13</sup> Then Samuel took the horn of oil and anointed him in the midst of his brothers; and the Spirit of the Lord came upon David from that day forward. So Samuel arose and went to Ramah.

<sup>18</sup> Then one of the servants answered and said, “Look, I have seen a son of Jesse the Bethlehemite, who is skillful in playing, a mighty man of valor, a man of war, prudent in speech, and a handsome person; and the Lord is with him.”
