

Memory Verse Review Phrases

TEACHER INSTRUCTIONS

Print and cut out the phrases. If you expect to have more than 12 students, cut some of the pieces smaller between words.

GAME DIRECTIONS

Use tape to attach the cut out words of the verse to the back of each student. Put more than one piece on some students if you have fewer than 12. Make sure to put words from the verse in order when putting more than one piece on a student's back. If you have more than 12 students, cut the pieces smaller.

When each student has part of the verse taped to his back, have students work together to put themselves in order. Once they think they are standing in order, check the verse by reading the words out loud according to how they are standing.

Ask for volunteers to say the verse alone. Make this fun by allowing them to say the verse in a special way. For example, have them say the verse quietly, or in a high mouse-like voice, or while standing on one foot. For a special treat, hand out small prizes to the students who are able to say the verse without prompting.
