## **GAME DIRECTIONS**

- 1. Where did King David live according to the text we studied today? 2 Samuel 7:1–2.
  - a. A house of cedar.
- 2. Who were the two characters involved in the 2 Samuel passage we studied today? 2 Samuel 7:1–2. Allow two teams to answer.
  - a. King David.
  - b. The prophet Nathan.
- 3. Where was the ark of God kept? 2 Samuel 7:2.
  - a. In a tent.
- 4. David lived in a beautiful home made of cedar. What did he want to build for God? 2 Samuel 7:5.
  - a. A house for the ark of God. It would be a wonderful temple for the ark of God.

- 5. Who did God intend to build His house? 2 Samuel 7:12–13.
  - a. The seed of David—his son. Solomon.
- **6.** When would this happen? 2 Samuel 7:12.
  - a. After David died.
- 7. Who brought a message from the Lord to David? 2 Samuel 7:4–5.
  - a. The prophet Nathan.
- 8. The message contained a promise for David. God said He was going to establish a kingdom after David died. How long would that kingdom last? 2 Samuel 7:16.
  - a. Forever.
- 9. God blessed David with a promise that one day, after David died, one of his future descendants would be a king whose kingdom would never end. Who was the promise talking about? 2 Samuel 7:16.
  - a. Jesus Christ, the promised Messiah.
- 10. Isaiah 9:6–7 has many words describing Jesus.


  Can you name one? Allow teams to answer one at a time until all six are named.
