Review Questions and Answer Key

PREPARATION

- Print the Game Numbers from the Resource DVD-ROM and cut the numbers apart. Place numbers in a cup or bowl . Optional: Dice can be used.
- Print enough Game Boards from the Resource DVD-ROM so that each team will have one.
- Bring in one button per team for a game piece.

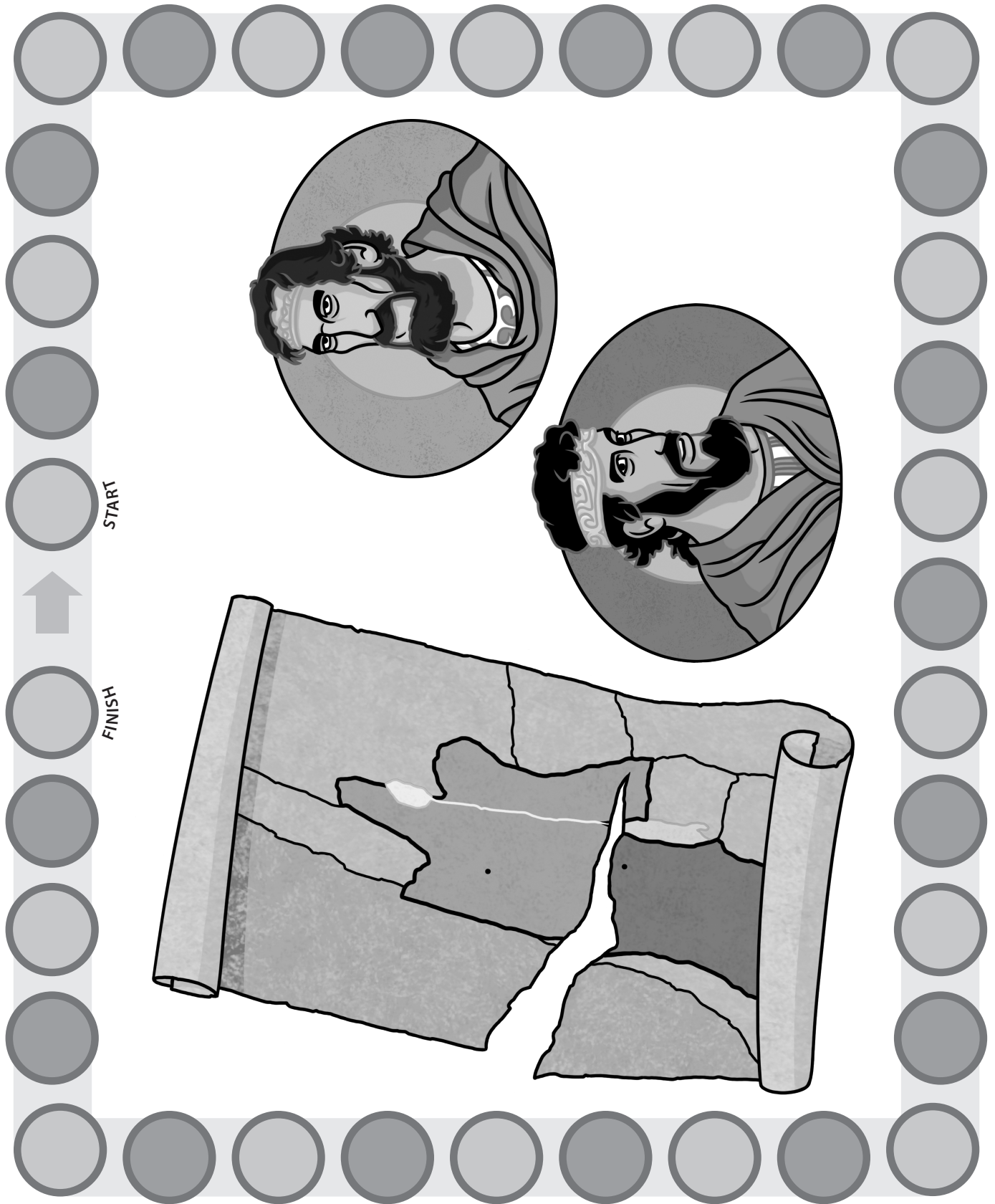
GAME DIRECTIONS

- Pass out a Game Board and a button to each team.
- Read the questions below alternating teams. If the team answers correctly they can draw a number from the cup and move their game piece.
- Give the Bible reference to the students so they can find the answers themselves.
- Repeat questions, in order to reinforce the answers.

QUESTIONS

1. What is one command God gave the kings of Israel? Allow alternating teams to answer. *Deuteronomy 17:16–17.*
 - a. *He shall not gather horses for himself.*
 - b. *He shall not have many wives.*
 - c. *He shall not gather together lots of silver and gold.*
2. Why did God command the kings to have only one wife? Allow alternating teams to answer. *Genesis 2:23–24, Exodus 20:3, 1 Kings 11:4.*
 - a. *God’s design for marriage is one woman and one man for life.*
 - b. *God knew that a foreign wife may turn the king away from the true God. The king would worship the foreign gods of his wives.*
3. What sin did Solomon’s wives lead him into? *1 Kings 11:4.* *Solomon turned to other gods—false gods. He was guilty of idolatry—worshipping false gods.*
4. When Solomon turned to idolatry, what did God say He would do because of Solomon’s sin? *1 Kings 11:9–11.*
 - a. *The kingdom would be torn away from him,*
 - b. *AND given to his servant.*
5. What was the name of Solomon’s son who took the throne after Solomon? *1 Kings 11:43.* *Rehoboam.*
6. What was the name of Solomon’s servant who spoke for the people? He asked Rehoboam to lighten up on the burden the people had to bear. *1 Kings 12:3.* *Jeroboam.*
7. When King Rehoboam answered the people, did he agree to lighten their burden or increase it? *1 Kings 12:14.* *No. He increased it.*
8. Whose plan was unfolding when the people rebelled against Rehoboam? *1 Kings 12:15.* *The Lord’s.*
9. What was the Northern Kingdom of Israel now called? *Look at the Lesson Theme Poster.* *Israel.*
10. Who was the king of the northern kingdom of Israel? *Look at the Lesson Theme Poster.* *Jeroboam.*
11. What was the southern kingdom now called? *Look at the Lesson Theme Poster.* *Judah.*
12. Who was the king of the southern kingdom? *Look at the Lesson Theme Poster.* *Rehoboam.*
13. How was Rehoboam related to Solomon? *1 Kings 11:43.* *He was his son.*
14. How was Jeroboam related to Solomon? *1 Kings 11:11.* *He was his servant.*
15. Which attribute of God shows us that He must punish sin? *Look at the Attributes of God poster.* *Just.*
16. Which attribute of God assures us that God is always in complete control of everything and He does as He pleases? *Look at the Attributes of God poster.* *Sovereign.*
