## PART 1 Ezra reads, and the people realize their sin against God. (Nehemiah 8:2-3, 8:5-9)

- 1. The leader Ezra was a priest.
- 2. He read from the book of the Law—God's Word.
- Ezra read from early morning until lunch time!
- 4. When Ezra began to read, the people stood up. This was a sign of respect for God and His Word.
- 5. As Ezra read, the people answered, "Amen." This meant they agreed with the Word of God that Ezra was reading.
