- 1. The nation of Persia is the location of all the events in the book of Esther.
- 2. The king became angry with the queen and removed her from the throne.
- 3. The king wanted a new queen, so he gathered the beautiful young women of his kingdom.
- 4. Hegai, who was in charge of all the women, liked Esther above all the other women and treated her well.
- 5. Esther came before the king. The king <u>loved</u> her more than all the other women.
- 6. He put the royal <u>crown</u> on Esther's head and made her queen.
- 7. After Esther became Queen, Mordecai overheard two men who were planning to kill the king.
- 8. Mordecai told Queen Esther. Queen Esther told the king. The king's life was saved. The men were hanged on a gallows.
- 9. The plot to kill the king was recorded, including the fact that it was <u>Mordecai</u> who warned the queen that the king was in danger.
