## **Pick a Point Questions**

Ask these questions during the Pick a Point Game. Allow teams to look up the answer in the Bible, if necessary. Repeat the questions if time allows.

- 1. What did Nehemiah do when he heard the bad news about Jerusalem? Nehemiah 1:4. Sat down and wept.
- 2. The king asked Nehemiah what was wrong with him. What did Nehemiah do before he answered the king? *Nehemiah 1:4. Prayed.*
- 3. What had happened to the walls around Jerusalem? Nehemiah 1:3. The walls had been broken down and the gates burned with fire.
- 4. Which attribute of God describes God as being in control of everything? Sovereign.
- 5. Can you recite our last memory verse? It was Proverbs 21:1. The king's heart is in the hand of the Lord, like the rivers of water; He turns it wherever He wishes.
- 6. What did the king notice about Nehemiah? How did Nehemiah's face look? Nehemiah 2:2. Sad.
- 7. Where did Nehemiah want to go? Nehemiah 2:5. Back to Jerusalem in Judah.
- **8.** What did Nehemiah want to rebuild? *Nehemiah 2:5. The wall of Jerusalem.*
- 9. Not everyone wanted the walls rebuilt. What did the people want to do to stop Nehemiah and his workers? Nehemiah 4:7. Attack Jerusalem and create confusion.
- 10. What did Nehemiah tell all the workers to carry with them? Nehemiah 4:17. Their weapons, swords.
- 11. And if trouble came to Jerusalem and they came under attack, what would the warning be to the city? *Nehemiah 4:20. The sound of a trumpet.*
- 12. Nehemiah believed someone would fight for them. Who was that? Nehemiah 4:20. God.
- 13. What is the memory verse we are working on now? Nehemiah 9:6 You alone are the Lord; You have made heaven, the heaven of heavens, with all their host, the earth and everything on it, the seas and all that is in them. And You preserve them all. The host of heaven worships You.
