

The Great I AM Review Game Teacher Guide

Print one copy for your use. Teams will alternate answering questions, picking points, and moving around the game board.

PREPARATION

- Print and cut out the Game Numbers. Place numbers in a cup or bowl so the teams can draw them out.
- Print one Game Board for each team.
- Distribute a button or coin to each team for game pieces.

GAME DIRECTIONS

- Divide the class into teams.
- Pass out a game board and a button or coin to each team.
- Teams will alternate drawing the numbers from a cup and answering review questions.
- Someone from the team will give the answer. If correct, the team will move forward according to the number drawn.
- If the team misses the question, the teacher will give the correct answer, and the same question may be repeated later in the game. Go on to the next team.
- Repeat questions if time allows.

The Great I AM Review Game Questions

Print one copy for your use. Teams will alternate answering the questions, picking points, and moving around the game board. Students may use their class notes and the Lesson Theme Poster to answer the questions.

1. What did God call Himself when He spoke with Moses? Exodus 3:14. *I AM.*
2. What does God's name, I AM, mean? *God is the only true, eternal God.*
3. Jesus said Abraham had seen His day. Abraham lived 2,000 years before Jesus. How could that be true? John 8:58. *Jesus is God. He is eternal. He existed when Abraham existed, etc.*
4. Why did the Jews get so angry when Jesus said, I AM? *The Jews knew Jesus was claiming to be God because "I AM" was God's name.*
5. The Jewish leaders were angry that Jesus claimed to be God. So what did they do? John 8:59. *They picked up stones to throw at Him and wanted to kill Him.*
6. Jesus used word pictures to identify Himself. He described Himself as a food. What kind of food was it? John 6:35. *The bread of life.*
7. What does it mean that Jesus is the bread of life? *Just like food is needed for physical life, Jesus is necessary for eternal life. We can't get to heaven without Him.*
8. How can knowing and believing in Jesus clearly guide our way? John 8:12. *He is the light of the world.*
9. Jesus said we cannot enter heaven except through Him. What word picture did He use to describe that? John 10:9. *I am the door.*
10. Jesus compared Himself to someone who protects, guides, disciplines, loves, comforts, feeds, and cares for something. What was that? John 10:11. *A good shepherd.*
11. Jesus said, "I am the resurrection and the life." What did He mean? *He is risen. He has conquered death. He can give eternal life.*
12. What is our memory verse? *John 14:6.*
13. Who is the way, the truth, and the life? John 14:6. *Jesus.*
14. If someone on your team can recite the memory verse, you can pick a point! John 14:6. *Allow one person from each team to recite the verse from memory. "Jesus said to him, 'I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through Me.'"*
