

# Four in a Row Teacher Guide

Print one sheet to guide you through the activity.

## INSTRUCTIONS

Use masking tape to make a 16-section square on the floor. The square should be four sections wide by four sections high. Each section should be equal in size. Cut 8 red circles and 8 black circles from the red and black construction paper. (Or use other appropriate markers for the two teams.)

Divide the students into two teams—red team and black team. Give each team eight paper circles—either red or black. Students will toss the beanbag to a square. They will answer a question. If they answer correctly, they can put a marker in that square.

To win the game, teams must get four circles in a row—achieved by answering the questions correctly.

1. In Luke 4:28 Jesus was teaching in the synagogue. How did the people respond to what Jesus was saying? *They were filled with wrath.*
2. What did the angry people want to do to Jesus in Luke 4:29? *They took Him out of the city and to the top of the hill. They wanted to throw Him off the cliff and kill Him.*
3. True or False. In John 5 Jesus healed a man who could not walk. The Jews persecuted Him for it and looked for a way to kill Him. *True. John 5:16.*
4. We read that the Jews were angry after Jesus said that He is God. How did they want to kill Him? *John 10:31. By throwing stones at Him.*
5. Some people were angry with Jesus and wanted to kill Him. But what was another way people reacted to His teaching? *They were astonished.*
6. Why were the people astonished at Jesus's teaching? *Matthew 7:29. He taught with authority, not like the scribes.*
7. Why was Jesus's teaching so different from the scribes and other teachers? *Because He is God.*
8. What were the two reactions the people had to Jesus and His teaching? *Some people hated Him, and others were astonished at Him.*
9. What happens to a person who does NOT believe in Jesus? *John 3:18. He is condemned.*
10. What happens to a person who DOES believe in Jesus? *John 3:18. He is not condemned.*
11. What happens to people who have eternal life when they die? *They go to heaven. They are not condemned by God.*
12. What happens to people who do not have eternal life when they die? *They go to hell. They are condemned by God.*
13. What is the memory verse we are working on? *John 14:6.*
14. How does John 14:6 describe Jesus? *The way, the truth, and the life.*
15. What is the only way we can get to the Father? *John 14:6? Through Jesus Christ.*
