
Pick a Point Questions Sheet

Ask these questions during the Pick a Point Review Game. Allow teams to look up the answer in the Bible, if necessary. Repeat the questions if time allows.

- 1. Where did Jesus go at the time of Passover? John 2:13. Jerusalem.
- 2. What is the Passover? What were the Jews remembering? Passover was a holiday the Israelites celebrated to remember God's faithfulness to them when He led them out of slavery in Egypt.
- 3. Where was Jesus when He made a whip of cords? John 2:14–15. The Temple.
- 4. How did Jesus defend God's honor in the Temple, using the whip? John 2:15. He drove out the animals and sellers.
- 5. What did Jesus do to the money changers? John 2:15. He poured out the money and overturned the tables.
- 6. What animals were being sold in the Temple? John 2:15. Animals for sacrifice: sheep, oxen, and doves.
- 7. Why was Jesus so angry at the money changers and the sellers? John 2:16 The Temple was a house of prayer and worship, not a house of merchandise.
- **8. Why was Jesus's anger not sin?** *It was righteous anger because He was defending God's honor.*
- 9. Jesus said, "Woe to you" to the Pharisees. What does that mean? How dare you?
- **10.** What was a Pharisee? A religious leader and teacher.
- **11. Jesus called the Pharisees hypocrites. What is a hypocrite?** Someone who pretends to be something they are not. Their outward actions do not match what is in their heart. Someone who says one thing and does another.
- 12. What kind of tomb did Jesus say the scribes and Pharisees were like? a) new tomb, b) whitewashed tomb, or c) ancient tomb? Matthew 23:27. B) whitewashed tomb.
- 13. How do whitewashed tombs appear on the outside? Matthew 23:27. They are clean and beautiful.
- 14. But what is inside a tomb? Matthew 23:27. Dead men's bones and uncleanness.
- **15. When are you NOT a hypocrite?** When you love God on the outside with actions and on the inside with your heart.
