1. Who did Jesus look forward to celebrating His last Passover meal with? *Luke 22:14. His 12 apostles/disciples.*
2. True or false. The Passover meal was a time for the Jews to remember when God brought them out of slavery in Egypt. *True.*
3. What did Jesus use to represent His body and His blood? *Luke 22:19–20. Bread and wine.*
4. Was the wine in the cup Jesus's actual blood? *No. It only stood for His blood.*
5. Jesus was preparing the disciples for an event that was about to happen by talking about His body and blood. What was the event? *His death on the Cross.*
6. During the last meal, Jesus said "Do this in remembrance of me." What special celebration was He changing? *Passover.*
7. Jesus changed the Jewish holiday, Passover, to be a special remembrance of Him. It's something celebrated in the Christian church. What is it called? *Communion or the Lord's Supper.*
8. What does the church now use during Communion to remember Jesus's sacrifice and the blood He shed for sinners? *Bread and wine (or grape juice).*
9. After the last Passover meal, Jesus and the apostles went to the garden to meet, pray, and be alone. Who arrived soon after Jesus got there? *John 18:3. Judas.*
10. Did Judas come alone or did he bring others with him? *John 18:3. He brought others.*
11. Who was with Judas? *John 18:3. Troops and officers from the chief priests and Pharisees.*
12. What were these troops and officers carrying? *John 18:3. Lanterns, torches, and weapons.*
13. What did Peter do when the troops approached Jesus? *John 18:10. He drew his sword and cut off the servant's right ear.*
14. Whose plan had this arrest been from the beginning? *John 18:11. God the Father's plan.*
15. Did Jesus go willingly with the troops who wanted to arrest Jesus, or did He try to fight against them? *He went willingly.*
16. Which disciple betrayed Jesus by bringing the troops? *Judas.*
17. Did Jesus know Judas was going to betray Him? *John 18:11. Yes.*
18. What does it mean that Jesus knew it was His time? *He knew the Father planned for Him to die for the sins of those who would believe. He knew these were the events leading up to that.*
