

# Too Scared To Talk About Jesus

**Characters:** Anna, Caleb, and Joshua

**Narrator:** Anna, Caleb, and Joshua have just heard a testimony by Mr. Michaels from their church. He is going to move to Albania, with Sarah and the rest of his family. He hopes to be able to share the gospel of Jesus Christ there. Mr. Michaels explained that it was the example of the Apostle Paul in the Bible that helped him decide to do this. We'll see what these three friends think of all of this.

**Anna:** Can you believe it? Sarah is going to be leaving! I can't believe her whole family is moving so far away!

**Caleb:** Man! They speak a completely different language in Albania! How will they even communicate? Did you talk to Sarah? What does she think about moving?

**Anna:** Well, she is sad and all. But she seems to be ready to go! She says the people in Albania just don't know about Jesus. There aren't very many churches there at all!

**Joshua:** She said she is looking forward to it! Even though she doesn't know the language. And she will be going to a public school there. She wants to meet other kids and she really hopes she can share the gospel!

**Caleb:** So, what do you guys think about telling people about Jesus and being missionaries?

**Anna:** Well, I'm pretty sure my family will never go that far away! So I guess I'll never be a missionary!

**Joshua:** I don't think we'll ever go on the mission field either. But, Anna, you don't have to travel far away to tell people about Jesus!

**Caleb:** That is true. Jesus wants us to talk to our friends about Him. It is important that they hear that He died on the Cross for sinners.

**Anna:** I know! But I feel funny about it! I get scared to talk about Him!

**Caleb:** But what about the people who get so angry when they hear about Him. Why do you think that is?

**Joshua:** You're right, Anna. And people don't want to change! They also don't like hearing they need a Savior.

**Caleb:** And they don't want to hear they are sinners and need forgiveness.

**Anna:** True! Because we know the gospel—that Jesus is the only way to heaven! He died on the Cross for sinners. And everyone who repents of his sin can be forgiven and saved! That isn't really too hard.

**Caleb:** You're right, Anna! We do know that much.

**Joshua:** But I think I could know a whole lot more! If I would just spend more time reading the Bible and studying it.

**Anna:** I agree, Joshua. Look at Sarah! She studies the Bible a lot. And she is ready to go all the way to Albania to talk to people about Jesus.

**Caleb:** I suppose that is the only way to get better at defending our faith and the truth in the Bible.
