SIN ENTERS THE WORLD

1. **Genesis 3:6** So when the woman saw that the tree was good for food, that it was pleasant to the eyes, and a tree desirable to make one wise, she took of its fruit and ate. She also gave to her husband with her, and he ate.

a. The first sin. Adam and Eve disobeyed God.

2. **Romans 5:12** Therefore, just as through one man sin entered the world, and death through sin, and thus death spread to all men, because all sinned.

a. One man, Adam, brought sin and death to all men—all men sin.

3. **Genesis 4:8** Now Cain talked with Abel his brother; and it came to pass, when they were in the field, that Cain rose up against Abel his brother and killed him.

a. Cain committed the first murder, caused by anger and greed and jealousy. Man is sinful.

4. **Genesis 6:5** Then the Lord saw that the wickedness of man was great in the earth, and that every intent of the thoughts of his heart was only evil continually.

a. Man is wicked and his heart is evil. Man is sinful.

MAN IS WICKED

5. **Jeremiah 17:9** The heart is deceitful above all things, and desperately wicked; Who can know it?

a. Our hearts are wicked and deceitful. Man is sinful.

6. **Romans 3:10–11** There is none righteous, no, not one; There is none who understands; there is none who seeks after God.

a. No one is righteous or good. No one seeks after God. Man is sinful.

7. **Romans 3:23** For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God.

a. All men are sinners.

GOD PROVIDES FORGIVENESS FOR OUR SINS THROUGH JESUS CHRIST

8. **John 3:16** For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life.

a. God gave His Son Jesus that those who believe in Him will have everlasting life.

9. **2 Corinthians 5:17** Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation; old things have passed away; behold, all things have become new.

a. In Jesus Christ our hearts can be made new.

10. **2 Corinthians 5:21** For He made Him who knew no sin to be sin for us, that we might become the righteousness of God in Him.

a. Jesus Christ was without sin, yet He took the punishment for sin so believers could be forgiven and saved.
