SIN ENTERS THE WORLD

- 1. Genesis 3:6 So when the woman saw that the tree was good for food, that it was pleasant to the eyes, and a tree desirable to make one wise, she took of its fruit and ate. She also gave to her husband with her, and he ate.
 - a. The first <u>sin</u>. Adam and Eve <u>disobeyed</u> God.
- **2. Romans 5:12** Therefore, just as through one man sin entered the world, and death through sin, and thus death spread to all men, because all sinned.
 - a. One man, Adam, brought sin and death to all men—all men sin.
- **3. Genesis 4:8** Now Cain talked with Abel his brother; and it came to pass, when they were in the field, that Cain rose up against Abel his brother and killed him.
 - a. Cain committed the first <u>murder</u>, caused by <u>anger</u> and <u>greed</u> and <u>jealousy</u>. Man is <u>sinful</u>.
- **4. Genesis 6:5** Then the Lord saw that the wickedness of man was great in the earth, and that every intent of the thoughts of his heart was only evil continually.
 - a. Man is <u>wicked</u> and his <u>heart</u> is <u>evil</u>. Man is <u>sinful</u>.

MAN IS WICKED

5. Jeremiah 17:9 The heart is deceitful above all things, and desperately wicked; Who can know it?

- Our hearts are <u>wicked</u> and <u>deceitful</u>.
 Man is <u>sinful</u>.
- **6. Romans 3:10–11** There is none righteous, no, not one; There is none who understands; there is none who seeks after God.
 - a. No one is <u>righteous</u> or <u>good</u>. No one seeks after God. Man is sinful.
- **7. Romans 3:23** For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God.
 - a. All men are sinners.

GOD PROVIDES FORGIVENESS FOR OUR SINS THROUGH JESUS CHRIST

- **8. John 3:16** For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life.
 - a. God gave His Son Jesus that those who believe in Him will have everlasting life.
- **9. 2 Corinthians 5:17** Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation; old things have passed away; behold, all things have become new.
 - a. In <u>Jesus Christ</u> our hearts can be made new.
- **10. 2 Corinthians 5:21** For He made Him who knew no sin to be sin for us, that we might become the righteousness of God in Him.
 - a. <u>Jesus Christ</u> was without sin, yet He took the <u>punishment</u> for sin so believers could be <u>forgiven</u> and saved.
