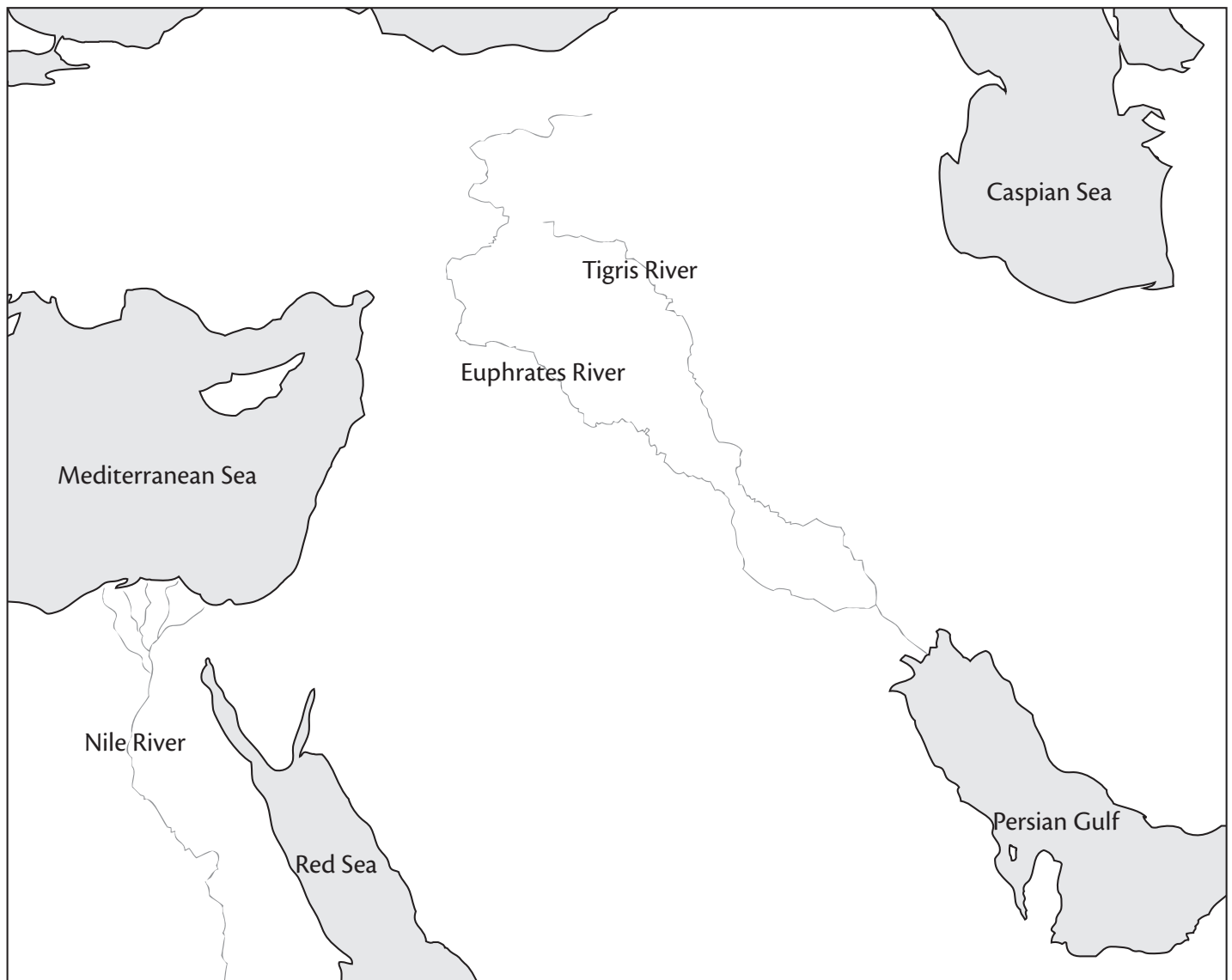


Mapping the Nations

1. Read 2 Samuel 18:20–23. One part of this grandson’s descendants settled to the west of the Red Sea and east of the Nile. This grandson’s name means “dark” in Hebrew. _____
2. Read Jeremiah 49:34–46 and Acts 2:7–9. This grandson settled north of the Persian Gulf and his descendants are also called Persians. _____
3. Read Esther 1:19 and Acts 2:7–9. This grandson’s name is the basis for this people group (though it is slightly modified) who settled southwest of the Caspian Sea. _____

3. Read Esther 1:19 and Acts 2:7–9. This grandson’s name is the basis for this people group (though it is slightly modified) who settled southwest of the Caspian Sea. Madai, son of Japheth
