- 4. Joseph's name is inscribed in Egyptian hieroglyphics. False, though there is a Menuhotep who might be Joseph.
- 5. The Great Pyramid was built around 2600 BC. False, the Flood occurred at 2349 BC, so the pyramids must have been built after that.
- 6. Moses would have taken the throne of Egypt as a pharaoh had he not fled to Midian. Probably, but there is no clear biblical text that states he would have become pharaoh. Many movies and other re-creations make this claim. It makes for good drama, but it is not necessarily true.
- 7. Many secular historians doubt the account of the Exodus because they are looking for evidence in the wrong time period. True, they typically look in the Eighteenth Dynasty rather than the end of the Twelfth Dynasty.
