

# The Lamb of God

*Gather the children into a circle. Give one child a stuffed lamb or other comparable item. Instruct him that when he hears the word "lamb" he should toss the stuffed lamb across the circle to a classmate. The person who caught the lamb should do the same thing for the next verse, and so on.*

*Read the verse again. This time after each verse, ask the question, "Who is the Lamb of God?" and have the children toss the lamb and answer, "Jesus!"*

**1 Corinthians 5:7** For indeed Christ, our Passover [**Lamb**], was sacrificed for us.

**John 1:29** The next day John saw Jesus coming toward him, and said, "Behold! The **Lamb** of God who takes away the sin of the world!"

**John 1:36** And looking at Jesus as He walked, he said, "Behold the **Lamb** of God!"

**Acts 8:32** He was led as a sheep to the slaughter; and as a **lamb** before its shearer is silent, so He opened not His mouth.

**1 Peter 1:19** But with the precious blood of Christ, as of a **lamb** without blemish and without spot.

**Revelation 5:12** Worthy is the **Lamb** who was slain to receive power and riches and wisdom, and strength and honor and glory and blessing!

**Revelation 5:13** Blessing and honor and glory and power be to Him who sits on the throne, and to the **Lamb**, forever and ever!
