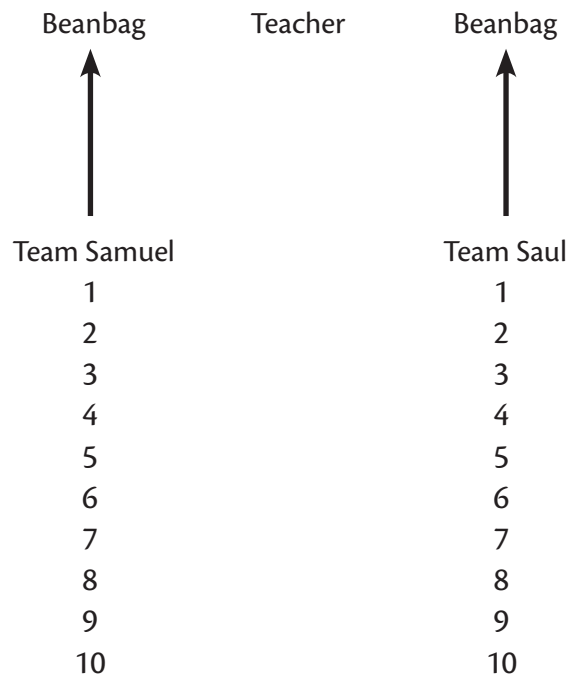


# Beanbag Review Game

## TEACHER INSTRUCTIONS:

Print one copy of these instructions for your use in class. Divide the students into two even teams—team Samuel and team Saul. Set beanbags a good distance from the teams. (Playing this game outside or in the hallway may work better.) Assign students on each team a number beginning at 1. Students will line up in their teams according to their numbers. When you call out “one, two, etc.,” the students with that number will race to grab their beanbag and get back to their team. The student back to the team first will give their team a chance to earn points by answering one of the review questions below. The entire team can help answer the question. If the team can’t answer the question correctly, you can give the other team the opportunity to answer. Or give the answer and repeat the question later.

Students should return the beanbags and you can continue with students “two.” Continue play until all of the questions are read. Record the points for each team on the board. The team with the most points at the end is the winner.



## REVIEW QUESTIONS:

1. What book of the Bible did we study from today? *1 Samuel*
2. Finish our memory verse: But the Lord said to Samuel, “Do not look at his appearance or at his physical stature, because I have refused him. For the Lord does not see as man sees; for man looks at the outward appearance, but the Lord \_\_\_\_.” *Looks at the heart*
3. Who was the last judge of Israel? *Samuel*
4. What did the people want? *A king*
5. What did Samuel do when he was upset that the people wanted a king? *He prayed*
6. Who did the people reject by asking for a king? *God, the Lord*
7. Did the people listen to God’s warning? *No*
8. How was the king going to act toward the people? *Not nice, he would turn their children into servants and slaves, take their food and animals*
9. Why did the people want a king? *To be like the other nations*
10. Who called the people together to choose a king? *Samuel*
11. Who did God choose as the first king of Israel? *Saul*
12. What did the people say when the king was chosen? *Long live the king*
13. What word on our Attributes poster means that God is in control of all things? *Sovereign*
14. 1 John 2:15 says, “Do not love the \_\_\_\_.” *world or things in the world*
