<u>Saul</u>	King Saul—first king of Israel—the main person in our historical account today.
<u>Philistines</u>	Israel's enemy. Mean warriors and fighters. Attacked Israel with a huge army.
<u>Samuel</u>	The great prophet of God; the man King Saul was supposed to wait for.
<u>Offering</u>	King Saul made the offering to get God's protection and blessing, but only Samuel was allowed to do it. He was God's prophet.
<u>Amalekites</u>	The enemies of God. Saul was commanded to destroy them completely.
<u>Disobeyed</u>	Saul did not listen. He should have waited for Samuel to make the sacrifice, and he should have destroyed all of the Amalekites.
<u>Judge</u>	What God must do when His people disobey Him. God must punish sin.
<u>Kingdom</u>	God judged Saul's disobedience by taking the kingdom away from him.
