Rahab Review Toss

Divide your class into teams of three to four students. One student from each team will step up to the tossing line and toss the beanbag on top of a review card. If the student misses the card it is the next team's turn. If the student hits a card, turn the card over and read it to the team who threw the beanbag. The entire team can help the student who tossed the beanbag answer the question. The other teams should not answer and wait their turn. If a question is answered incorrectly, the card is turned back over in the same place. If a question is answered correctly, the card is taken out of the game, and the corresponding points are awarded to the team. Play continues while each team and the players on the teams take turns tossing the beanbag onto the review cards. The game ends when all of the questions have been answered correctly and there are no more cards on the floor. The team with the most points at the end of the game wins.
