- 7. Who came and spoke to Gideon? **The Lord**
- 8. Which army began with 32,000 men? The Israelites
- 9. Who did the Lord promise to be with? **Gideon**
- 10. Which army used trumpets, pitchers and torches? **The Israelites**
- 11. Who had a different plan? The Lord
- 12. Which army ended up with 300 men? The Israelites
- 13. Who led the Israelites into battle? Gideon
- 14. Which army was ready to obey God? The Israelites
- 15. Who was not mighty by himself? **Gideon**
- 16. Who kept attacking the Israelites? **The Midianites**
- 17. Who was a judge? **Gideon**
- 18. Who is sovereign? **The Lord**
- 19. Which army ran, cried out, and fled? The Midianites
- 20. Whose plan was accomplished in the end? **The Lord**
