## Altar Made of Stones (God Uses Elijah Review Questions)

**Preparation:** Fill up 15 paper lunch bags with crumpled newspaper. Slide another bag on top of the open side of the filled bags and tape together to make a "stone." Number the stones 1–15 and stack them so the teams can see the numbers.

**Play:** Divide the class into two teams and stack the "stones" in one pile in front of the teams. Each team will build an altar with the stones. Team members will choose a stone with a number on it and answer the corresponding review question. If they get the answer correct, they take the stone and begin to build their altar. The other team then takes a turn and play continues until all of the stones are gone. If a team answers incorrectly, give the other team an opportunity to answer and take the stone. Encourage the students to stack the stones on top of each other in a circle formation to make their altars. The team with the most stones wins.

If neither team can answer the question, re-read the Scripture shown below.

- 1. What book of the Bible did we read from today? 1 Kings.
- 2. Who was God's prophet we talked about today? Elijah. 1 Kings 18:1.
- 3. How many false prophets of Baal were there? 450. 1 Kings 18:22.
- 4. What did the false prophets of Baal do around their altar? Shout, jump, cry out. 1 Kings 18:26.
- 5. Where did the sacrifice take place? Mount Carmel. 1 Kings 18:20.
- 6. How long did the prophets of Baal call out to Baal to send fire? Morning till noon. 1 Kings 18:26.
- 7. What happened to Baal's altar? Nothing. No fire came down. 1 Kings 18:26.
- 8. What did Elijah add to his altar that the false prophets did not? Water. 1 Kings 18:33.
- 9. Why did Elijah put water on his altar? So the people would know that God is the only Lord God. 1 Kings 18:37.
- 10. How many times did Elijah ask God to send fire? Once. 1 Kings 18:37.
- 11. What happened to Elijah's altar? The fire burnt up everything—the sacrifice, the wood, the stones, and the water. 1 Kings 18:38.
- 12. What did the people do who saw the fire burn up Elijah's altar? They fell down and worshipped God. 1 Kings 18:39.
- 13. What is worshipping false gods called? Idolatry.
- **14.** Who should we worship? The one true God, the Lord God.
- 15. What is the Scripture reference from our memory verse? 1 Chronicles 29:11.
