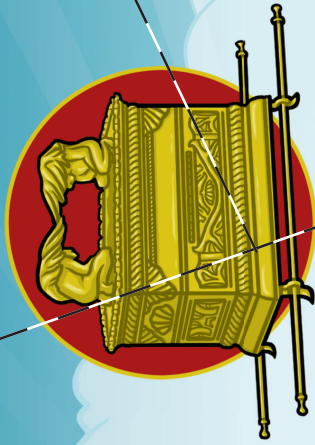
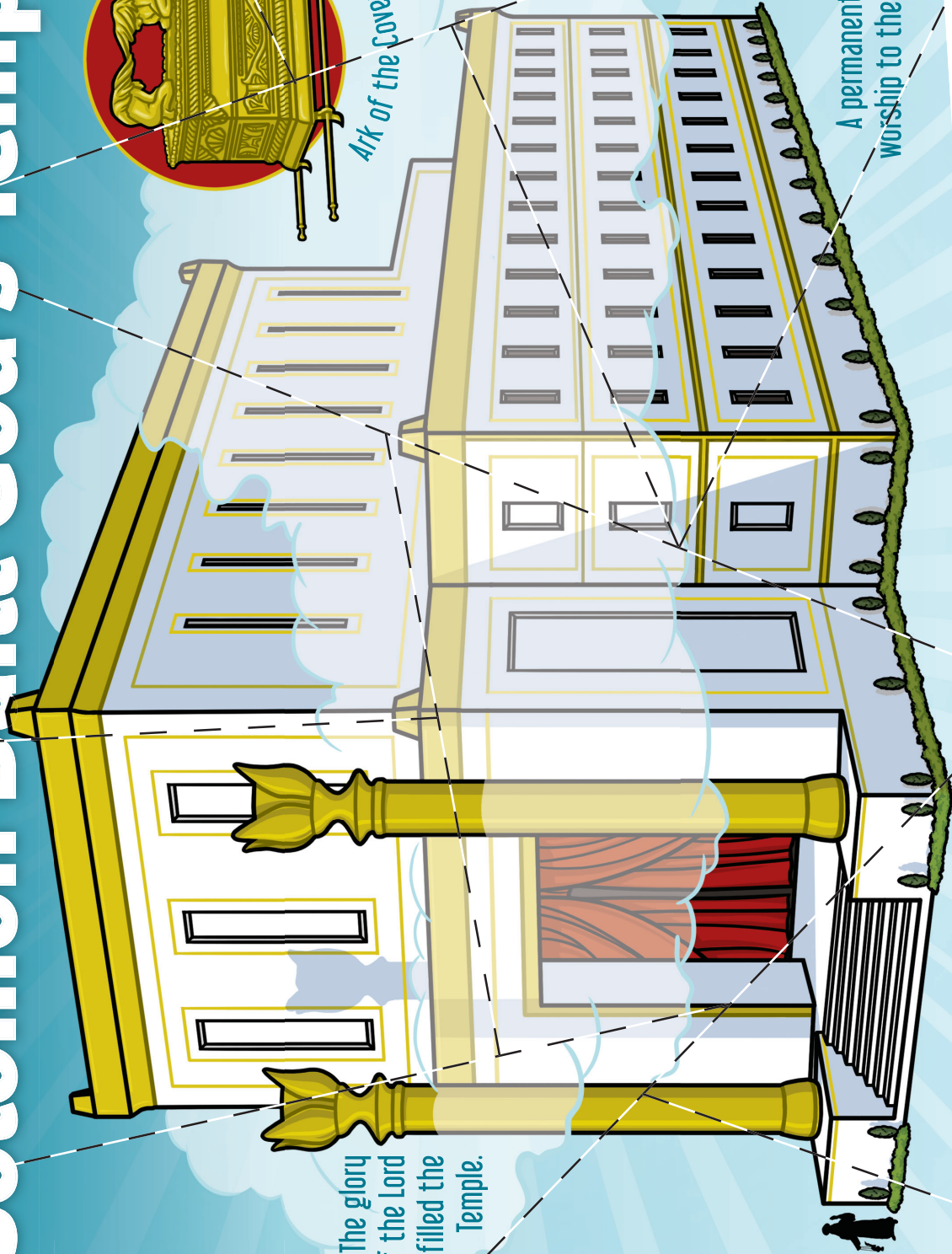


# Solomon Built God's Temple

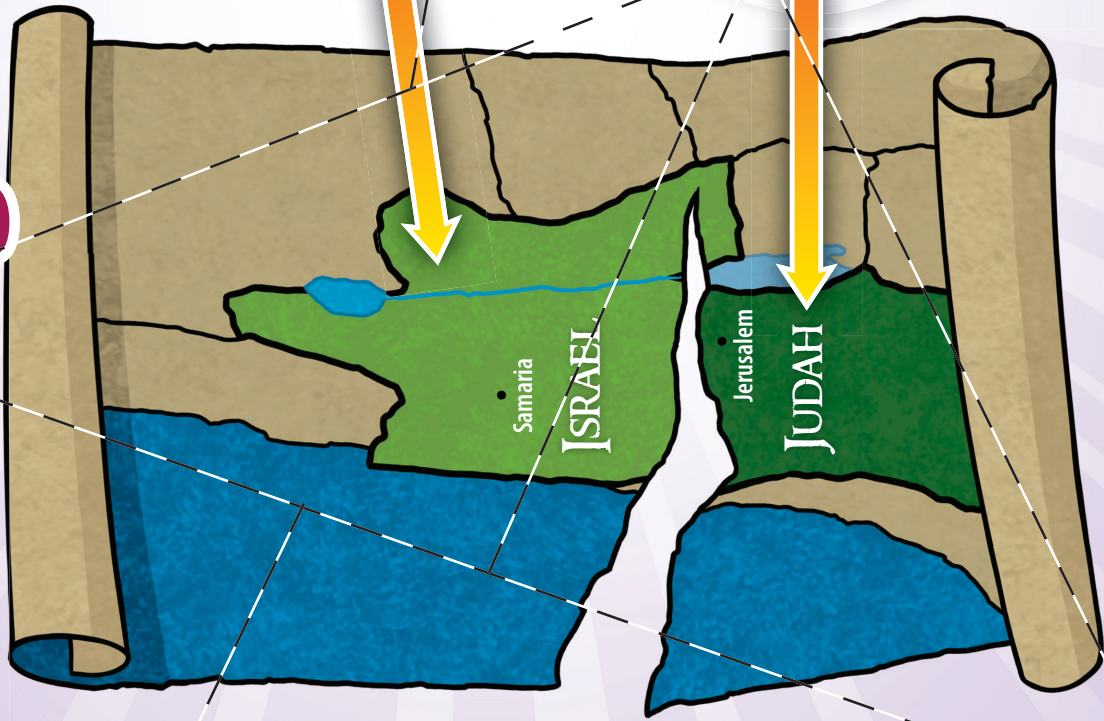

1 Jonah disobeyed God and ran away.



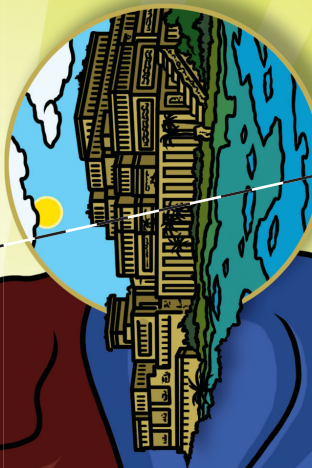
3 God sent a fish to swallow Jonah.
