David's Review Bounce

Print one copy for your use in class.

Bring in a rubber playground ball. Have the children stand in a circle. Ask a question. Have the students raise their hands if they know the answer. Bounce the ball to one of the students. When the student has answered, he can bounce the ball back to you. Continue through the questions, allowing different students to catch the ball and bounce it back to you. Repeat the questions if time.

- 1. What eternal King would come from David's family? Jesus.
- 2. Where was King David when his troops were at war? At home, not with them.
- 3. Who did David take from Uriah? His wife.
- 4. What did King David do to Uriah? Had him killed.
- 5. Who did King David sin against? God and/or Uriah.
- 6. What is another word for a parable? A story.
- 7. Who told King David a parable and helped him see his sin? The prophet Nathan.
- 8. What was the parable about? A rich man, a poor man, and a lamb.
- 9. How many sheep did the rich man have? Lots!
- 10. How many sheep did the poor man have? One.
- 11. How did the poor man feel about his only sheep? He loved it like his own daughter.

- 12. What did the rich man do with the poor man's sheep? Killed it!
- 13. How did King David feel after he heard the parable about the rich man who killed the poor man's lamb? He was angry at the rich man.
- 14. Who was the parable of the rich man, the poor man, and the lamb about? Who was the rich man? *King David.*
- 15. Did King David ask for forgiveness? Yes, he repented.
- 16. How does God feel about sin? He hates it.
- 17. What is the Scripture reference from our memory verse? *2 Samuel 7:22*

NOTE: You may want to go into a memory verse review here. Have the students pass the ball as they recite each word of the memory verse either individually or together.
