- 1. Is God sovereign—in control of everything? Yes.
- 2. Was the nation divided because of King Solomon's sin? Yes.
- 3. Was Israel the southern kingdom? No. Northern Kingdom.
- 4. Did the people of Israel choose Jeroboam to be their king? Yes. 1 Kings 12:20.
- 5. 1 Kings 16:25 says that Omri did evil in the eyes of the LORD, and did worse than all who were before him. Was King Omri a good or evil king? *Evil.*
- **6.** Were the kings supposed to build idols to false gods? No. They were to follow the one true God.
- 7. Were all of the kings in Israel good or evil? Evil.
- 8. Were there 100 evil kings in Israel? No. There were 19.
