## **Tic-tac-toe Review Game**

Using masking tape, put a tic-tac-toe grid pattern on the floor large enough for a paper plate to fit inside each square. Divide the class into two teams. Give each team different colored paper plates—blue and red. Ask each team a question. If Blue Team answers correctly, they can play a plate on the tic-tac-toe grid. If the team cannot answer correctly, allow Red Team to answer. If no one gets the answer, give the correct answer and repeat the question later. Repeat the process above until a team gets tic-tac-toe. Continue play as time allows. Encourage the students to look at their class notes, the Lesson Theme Poster, and other posters that may help them during the game.
