Trivia Toss Answer Key

Print one set of the God Answers Prayer Trivia Toss Cards onto cardstock. Tape them to the floor face down. Students will divide into small teams. They will toss a beanbag onto a lesson question taped to the floor. Pull the question from the floor, allow students to answer it, and award the team with the number of points listed on the question. Use this answer key to confirm answers. Allow another team to answer if Team 1 doesn't know the answer. If no one gets the answer, give the answer and put the card back on the floor.

2.	Who was the Rabshakeh? A messenger. He spoke for the king of Assyria. 3 points.
3.	The Assyrian king told the people they could not trust their God. 1 point.
4.	The Assyrian king told the people someone was lying to them. Who was it? King Hezekiah. 2 points.
5.	What prophet spoke the Word of the Lord to King Hezekiah and the people? Isaiah. 2 points.
6.	Where did King Hezekiah go after he got the letter from the King of Assyria? To the House (Temple) of the Lord.

7.	What did King Hezekiah do in the Temple? He prayed. 2 points.
8.	Who did King Hezekiah want the victory to go to? God. 1 point.
9.	Who did God send into the Assyrian camp to destroy the army? The Angel of the Lord. 3 points.
10.	Who did King Hezekiah send his servants to for advice? Isaiah, the prophet. 3 points.
11.	What did Isaiah tell the people? Do not be afraid. 2 points.
12.	Which attribute of God describes God as all-powerful? Omnipotent. 1 point.
