# **Teacher Game Directions**


#### **DIRECTIONS**

Print and cut 1–3 sets of the Names of Jesus Game Cards and Student Actions Cards (depending on the size of your class). Have the class sit in rows facing each other—two teams. Explain the two types of cards and read what each says. Shuffle the cards and place them in two separate stacks face down on the floor between the students.

Assign two students from Team 1 to take one card from each stack. They should read the cards out loud (assist them if necessary) and return to their team. The team will then follow directions on the cards together. They will replace the cards when finished and then take a seat.

Assign two students from Team 2 to do the same. Continue as time allows.

Example: Susie picks the "Jesus is the Messiah—Say it four times" card and Max chooses the "Run in place" card. Susie, Max, and her team will stand up and say, "Jesus is the Messiah," four times while running in place.

Turn in a circle.

## **Action Card**

Jump on one foot.

## **Action Card**

Jump up and down.

# **Action Card**

Walk on your knees.

## **Action Card**

Grab a partner and spin in a circle.

High-five a friend as you repeat the name.

Jesus is the Good Shepherd. Say it 2 times.

#### **Name Card**

Jesus is the Messiah.
Say it 4 times.

## **Name Card**

Jesus is the Lion of Judah. Say it 2 times.

# **Name Card**

Jesus is everlasting. Say it 5 times.

#### **Name Card**

Jesus is the Word. Say it 6 times.

## **Name Card**

Jesus is Savior. Say it 5 times.

#### **Name Card**

Jesus is God. Say it 3 times.

#### **Name Card**

Jesus is the Ruler. Say it 3 times.
