Print one copy for your use during the review activity.

Bring in a rubber playground ball. Have the children stand in a circle. Ask a question. Have the students raise their hands if they know the answer. Bounce the ball to one of the students. If time allows, repeat the questions, allowing other students to participate.

- 11. What did the people finally do to Jesus? Killed Him.
- 12. Why did Jesus die? To save sinners.
- 13. What does iniquity mean? Sin.
- 14. What is the reference for our memory verse? Isaiah 53:6.
- 15. Who took the punishment for sinners? Jesus.
- **16.** How did Jesus take our punishment? He died on the Cross.
