

Nehemiah's Wall Relay Game

TEACHER INSTRUCTIONS:

- Make one copy of these directions and questions below for your use.
- Divide the class into two teams.
- Mark two start lines equal distance away from the board with masking tape.
- Use the diagram below to set up blocks on two trays.
- Put one tray with blocks on the floor for each team.



- On "Go," the first two students will pick up their trays and walk to the board as quickly as possible. If the blocks topple over, the student must stack them up again before moving forward.
- The first student to the board gets to answer a question to earn points for the team. (Read the Scripture listed, if needed.) Award the points listed on the questions below for each correct answer.





- If the student does not answer correctly, the other student at the board will have an opportunity to answer. If both students answer incorrectly, ask the question again later in the game.
- Students will return the tray to the next teammate.
 Blocks must be intact before the next teammate begins.
- Continue to play until all of the review questions are asked.
- Keep a list of the teams' points to determine the "winner" for the day.
- If time allows, repeat the questions!



REVIEW QUESTIONS:

- 1. What did Nehemiah hear about the walls in Jerusalem? What had happened to them? *Nehemiah 1:3. The walls had broken down and the gates were burned. 2 points.*
- 2. What did Nehemiah do when he heard the bad news about Jerusalem? Nehemiah 1:4. He prayed, sat down, and wept. 4 points.
- 3. The king asked Nehemiah what was wrong with him. What did Nehemiah do before he answered the king? *Nehemiah 2:4. Prayed. 3 points.*
- **4.** Who did Nehemiah pray to? Nehemiah 2:4. Lord God. 1 point.
- 5. Which attribute of God tells us He is in control of everything? Sovereign. 2 points.
- 6. How did Nehemiah appear to the king? Nehemiah 2:2. Sad. 3 points.
- 7. What was Nehemiah's job for the king? Nehemiah 1:11. The king's cupbearer. 2 points.
- 8. Where did Nehemiah want to go? Nehemiah 2:5. Back to Jerusalem. 2 points.
- **9.** What did Nehemiah want to rebuild? Nehemiah 2:5. The wall of Jerusalem. 1 point.
- 10. What did the people of Jerusalem say when Nehemiah told them about his plan to rebuild the wall? Nehemiah 2:18. Let's rebuild the walls. 3 points.
- 11. What did the angry people want to do to stop Nehemiah and his workers? Nehemiah 4:8. Attack Jerusalem and create confusion. Stop the building. 4 points.
- **12. What did Nehemiah tell all the workers to carry with them?** *Nehemiah 4:17. Their weapons, swords. 2 points.*
- 13. Who did Nehemiah say would fight for them? Nehemiah 4:20. God. 1 point.
- 14. What is the reference of the memory verse we are working on now? Nehemiah 9:6. 2 points.
- 15. What would Nehemiah's warning be if there was an attack to stop the work on the wall? Nehemiah 4:20. The sound of the trumpet. 4 points.
