

# Paul's Journey Game Teacher Guide

## INSTRUCTIONS

Place the ten Paul's Journey Game City Signs around the room. Divide the class into two or more teams depending on the class size. Each team will select one person to be "Paul" for that team. The "Pauls" will stand by the #1 Start sign. Read the names on the signs reminding the students where Paul's third journey took him. Ask the first team a question. If the students answer correctly, their "Paul" should move to the next city sign. If the students answer incorrectly, their "Paul" may not move. Ask the other team the same question. If the students answer it correctly their "Paul" may move AND that same team will also get a new question. The first team to reach the #10 Finish sign AND answer the question correctly at the finish sign, wins. If there is extra time, you may want to switch teams and "Pauls" and play again. Or, have the entire team "travel" together as they answer questions.

## PAUL'S JOURNEY GAME QUESTIONS

Ask these questions during the Paul's Journey Game. Allow teams to use their class notes, posters, lesson illustrations, and Bibles, if necessary.

1. Which of Paul's journeys did we talk about today, the first, second, or third? *Third.*
2. What city did Paul spend most of his time in during his third journey? *Ephesus.*
3. Who did Paul preach the gospel to as he traveled? Choose one. A. The Jews. B. The Gentiles. C. Jews and Gentiles. *Answer: C. Jews and Gentiles. Everyone!*
4. Paul first went to the synagogue to teach in Ephesus. How long did Paul preach in the synagogue? Choose one. A. Three months. B. Two days. C. Four weeks. *Answer: A. Three months.*
5. Who did Paul always speak boldly about? *Jesus.*
6. What did Paul always preach? Think about our memory verses. *The gospel of Jesus Christ. The message of the Cross.*
7. Some of the Jews spoke evil about Paul, and he left the synagogue. What did Paul do after he left the synagogue? *He preached in a different place in the city—the school of Tyrannus.*
8. Who came to hear Paul preach in this new place? *Jews and Gentiles.*
9. Where did Paul spend a lot of time on his third journey? Choose one. A. Philippi. B. Ephesus. C. Jerusalem. *Answer: B. Ephesus.*
10. What else did Paul do on his third journey? Choose one. A. Spoke to the king. B. Visited churches he had already been to. C. Took a vacation. *Answer: B. Visited churches he had already been to.*
11. What were the leaders of the church called that Paul talked to? *The elders.*
12. What did Paul want the elders to be like? Choose one. A. Shepherds. B. Sheep. C. Wolves. *Answer: A. Shepherds.*
13. Who did Paul compare the sheep to? Choose one. A. Elders. B. False Teachers. C. Believers. *Answer: C. Believers.*
14. Who are the savage wolves in the church? *False teachers.*
15. What do false teachers do? *Tell lies. Twist God's truth.*
