

Four in a Row Teacher Guide

INSTRUCTIONS

Use masking tape to make a 16-section square on the floor. The square should be four sections wide by four sections high. Each section should be equal in size. Cut 8 red circles and 8 black circles from the red and black construction paper. (Or use other appropriate markers for the two teams.)

Divide the students into two teams. Give each team eight paper circles—either red or black. They will take turns answering the questions. Allow them to use the class notes and posters. If they answer correctly, they can put a marker in a square on the grid. The first team to get four markers in a row wins the game.

FOUR IN A ROW QUESTIONS

Ask these questions during the game. Allow teams to use their class notes, posters, and Bibles, if necessary.

1. How many books in the New Testament were letters written by Paul? *13.*
2. Which of these is a letter that Paul wrote?
Choose one: A. Genesis. B. 1 Timothy. C. John.
Answer: B. 1 Timothy.
3. Which book was written to the believers in Ephesus? *Ephesians.*
4. Which of these is a letter that Paul wrote?
Choose one: A. Titus. B. 1 Kings. C. Luke. *Answer: A. Titus.*
5. Who did Paul write the letter of the Philippians to? *The believers in Philippi.*
6. How should believers treat each other? *With kindness and love.*
7. What book is the memory verse from? *1 Corinthians.*
8. Who wrote the book of 1 Corinthians? *Paul.*
9. Who did Paul write all the letters in the Bible to? *To churches and Christians.*
10. What does the Cross seem like to those who are perishing? Check the memory verse for a hint. *Foolishness.*
11. What does it mean when something is foolish? *It is silly or stupid.*
12. What is the message of the Cross to those who are being saved? Again, check out the memory verse. *The power of God.*
13. Who wrote the letter to the Galatians? *Paul.*
14. Which of these is one way God wants us to treat each other? Choose one: A. Be kind. B. Be hateful. C. Be angry. *Answer: A. Be kind.*
15. Which of these is one way God does NOT want us to treat others? Choose one: A. Be kind. B. Be mean. C. Be forgiving. *Answer: B. Be mean.*
