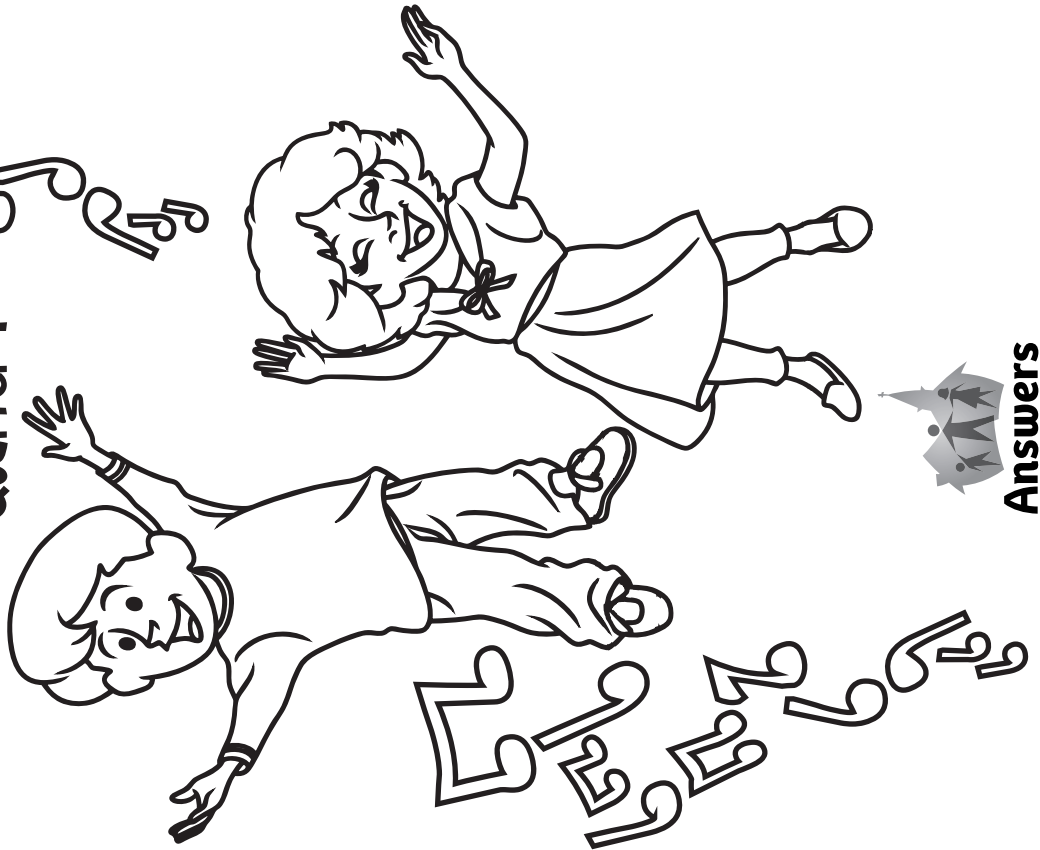


Family Time Song Book

(To the tune of "If You're Happy and You Know It")

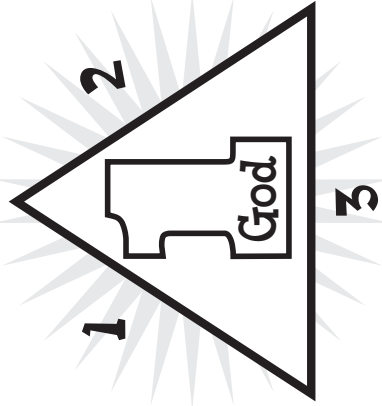
There is no one like our God, no there's not!

God's Word is all complete,

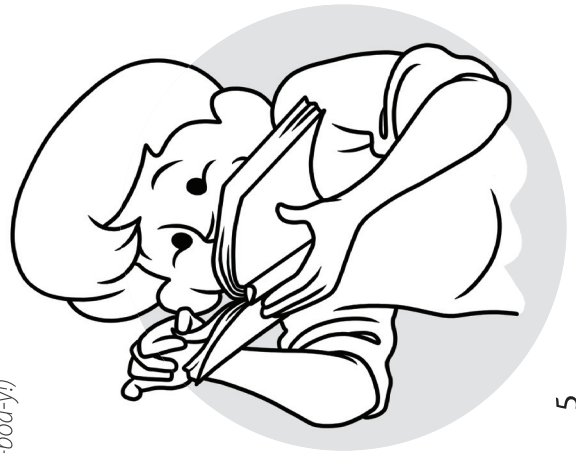
(Shoo fly, don't bother me!)
