

Puppet Role Play Script

Say: Boys and girls, I'd like to introduce some friends of mine. They heard that we've been learning all kinds of wonderful things from the Bible. So they asked me if they could come and talk with us and see if we can answer some of their questions.

Say: Here they are, [Puppet One and Puppet Two]. *Introduce their names and have them greet the children.*

Puppet One: We're so excited to be here!

Teacher: We're glad you're here. Do you have any questions we can help you with?

Puppet Two: *Turns toward class.* I have a question. We know the Bible is a special book and very important. But does the Bible tell people much about who God is?

Teacher: It sure does! For example, it tells us about the Trinity.

Puppet One: The what? *Turns toward class.*

Teacher: Say it with me class, "Tri-ni-ty." The Trinity means God is three persons in one.

Puppet One: Really? How can three people be one God?

Puppet Two: *Turns toward class.* I don't understand.

Teacher: It is hard for me to understand, too. I think of it this way. God in heaven is the Father. God who became man is Jesus. And God who lives in us and helps us is the Holy Spirit.

Puppet Two: Three different persons in one God! Wow!

Puppet One: I've also heard that God is a loving God.

Puppet Two: But, if God loves us so much, why do so many bad things happen?

Teacher: A lot of bad things do happen. But it wasn't supposed to be that way. When God created the world it was very good. The bad things started when Adam and Eve disobeyed God. When they sinned, they brought sin into the world. And now we all sin.

Puppet Two: So, the bad things aren't God's fault at all!

Puppet One: I don't like bad things that happen. Like when my friend's Grandma died. It was really sad.

Teacher: Yes, that is sad. But Jesus provides a way for us to one day be with Him forever! After we die.

Puppet Two: Really? What's that?

Teacher: Well, the Bible promises a place where there will be no more death or tears or pain. And all those who believe in Jesus as Savior will all be together again!

Puppet One: But I know some people who don't believe in Jesus. Do they HAVE to believe in Him to get to heaven?

Teacher: Yes. And the Bible tells us that. In fact, Jesus said He is the only way to heaven, and that no one can get to the Father except through Him.

Puppet Two: So, Jesus isn't just a good way to get to heaven, He is the ONLY way!!

Teacher: Yes, that's exactly right. *Turns toward class.* And how do we know this is true? *The Bible tells us so!*

Puppet One: I have another question! *Jumps around excitedly.* Does the Bible tell us where God came from?

Teacher: According to the Bible, God didn't come from anywhere! He always existed.

Puppet Two: I don't understand. How can someone always exist?

Teacher: There are some things in the Bible we may not understand, but we must accept because God said it, and God never lies. God is, God was, and He will be forever.

Puppet One: Wow! That's amazing!

Teacher: Yes! God's Word is amazing! That's why it can be so much fun to read it and learn from it.

Puppet One: Thanks for letting us come and talk with you and your class! I learned a lot!

Puppet Two: Yes! I think I understand a lot of things better now, too. *Turns toward class.* Thank you, everyone! Goodbye!

Puppets exit.
