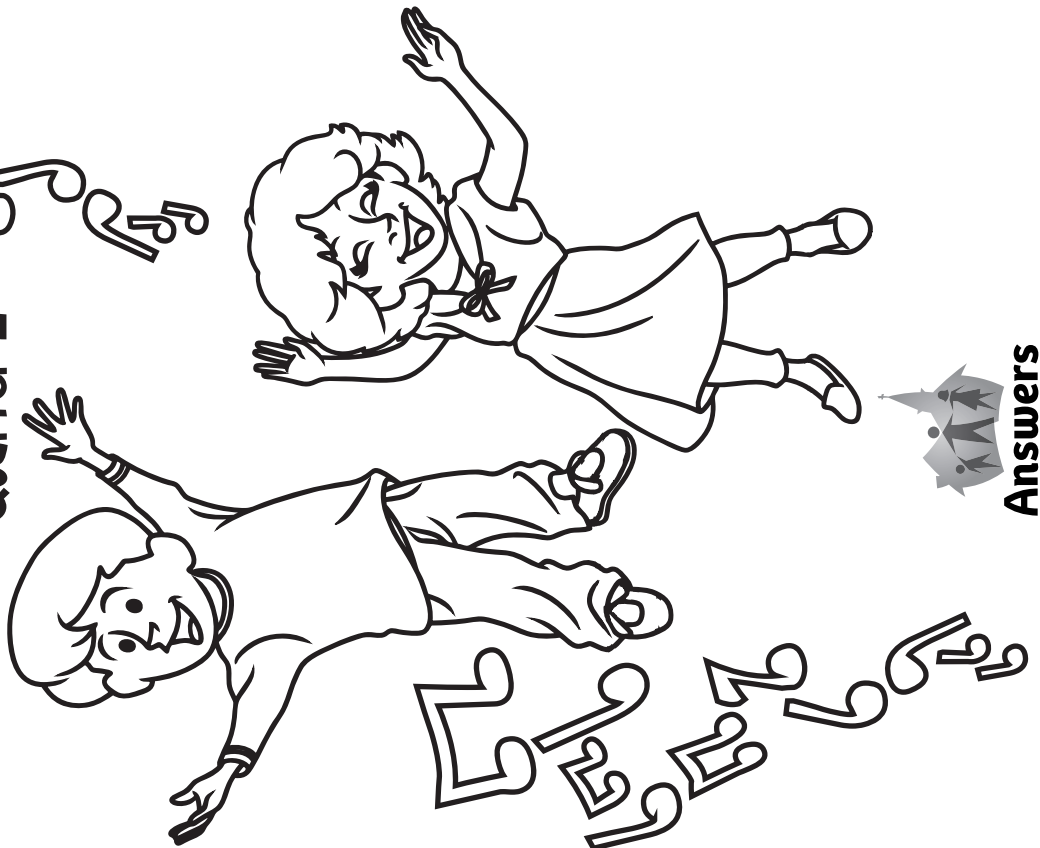


Family Time Song Book
