

# Puppet Role Play Script

*You can interact with the puppet, answering the questions yourself, or use two puppets to talk with each other. Allow the students to interact with the puppets as well.*

**Teacher:** Boys and girls, I'd like to introduce some friends of mine! They heard that we've been learning all kinds of wonderful things from the Bible. So they asked me if they could come and talk with us and see if we can answer some of their questions.

**Teacher:** Here they are, [Puppet One and Puppet Two]. *Introduce their names and have them greet the children.*

**Puppet One:** I'm so excited to be here! I like learning about the Bible!

**Puppet Two:** Me too! *Turns toward class.* So what special things have you been learning?

**Teacher:** We've been talking about how sin entered into creation. And because God is holy, He must punish sin.

**Puppet One:** My friend, Jacob, doesn't believe that. He doesn't think anyone goes to hell, either. He says we're all pretty good!

**Puppet Two:** Yeah, and my teacher at school says that all people are good. *Turns toward class.* But doesn't the Bible say we are all sinners?

**Teacher:** That's right. It does say we are all sinners. And because of that, we all deserve to be punished by God!

**Puppet One:** But what if we do just one sin? What if all I do is tell one lie to my mom that I didn't eat the cookie?

**Teacher:** Even one sin is enough to keep us out of heaven because God is holy and God hates all sin.

**Puppet Two:** But it seems like no one would ever get to heaven then. How can the boys and girls get to heaven? Can they do it . . . ever?

**Teacher:** Yes, they can! Because God made a way for us. He sent someone to earth to take the punishment for sin. Boys and girls, can you tell our friends who God sent to earth to live as a man?

**Children:** Jesus!

**Teacher:** That's right. *To the puppets.* Jesus is the only one who ever lived who didn't sin. He is the only one who can clean our hearts so we can be forgiven and go to heaven.

**Puppet One:** You mean, God can see if hearts are clean?

**Puppet Two:** Oh! I remember. God can see what's inside hearts. He knows if people really love Him deep down inside and if they really want to please Him.

**Teacher:** That's right. Remember Cain and Abel?

**Puppet One:** Yes, I do! I don't get why God wouldn't accept Cain's offering.

**Puppet Two:** *Turns toward class.* You know where we need to look don't you? In the Bible!

**Teacher:** Yes, very good! It says that Cain didn't love God. And God could see that in his heart. But God wants our obedience, love, and respect more than anything we can do for him.

**Puppet One:** Wow! *Turns toward class.* Do you want to love God and obey Him every day?

**Puppet Two:** Of course they do!

**Teacher:** That's great! Sometimes it's hard to do, but the Bible promises that Jesus will help you.

**Puppet One:** Thank you for answering our questions. I'm glad we can look in the Bible for answers!

**Puppet Two:** Yes! *Turns toward class.* Thank you, everyone!

**Puppets One and Two:** Good bye!
