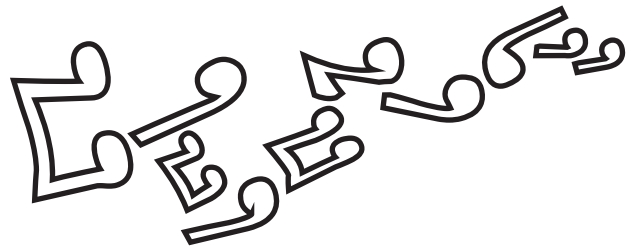
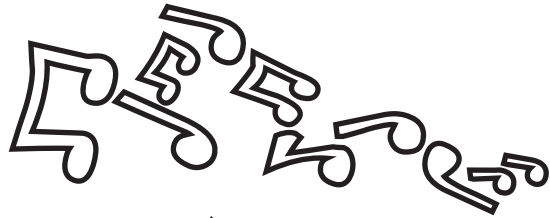


# Family Time Song Book
