

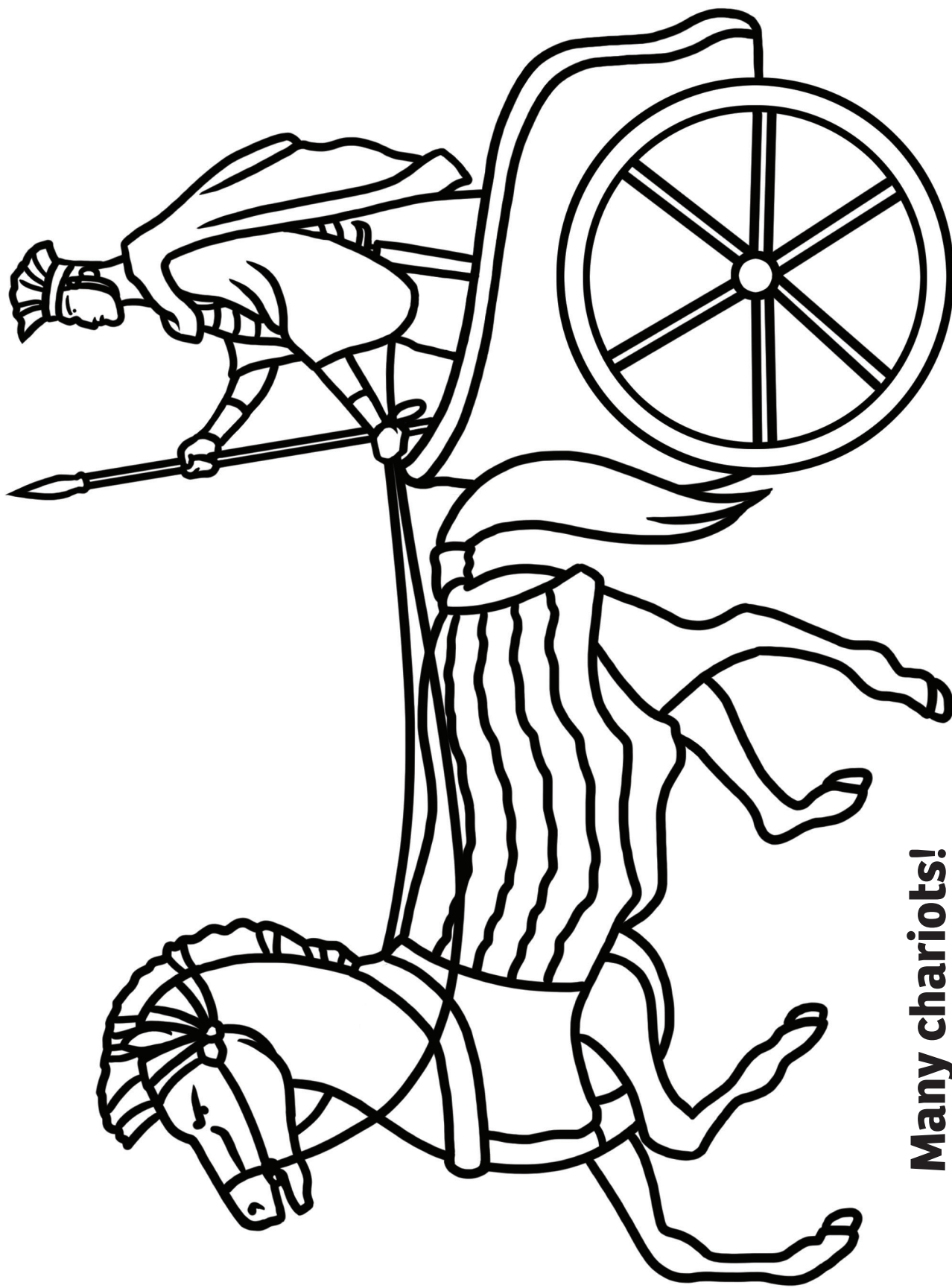
Review Coloring Sheets Script

Print at least one each of the six coloring sheets. Give one of the illustrations to each of the students. If you have more than six students, some will have the same picture. Students will color the Lesson Illustrations 1–6 from Lesson 11, then stand in order according to the number on their coloring sheet—1 to 6. Review Lesson 11 briefly using the coloring sheets and the following script.

1. The Philistines were a mean and very large army. They were coming against the Israelites.
2. They had 30,000 chariots to attack with!
3. The Bible said they had 6,000 horsemen! Ready to fight!
4. All the people were afraid! They ran and hid.
5. King Saul wondered what to do.
