LESSON 8

Ruth and her mother-in-law were in trouble. Their husbands had died, and they didn't have anyone to take care of them. But they trusted God to help them. Ruth worked in the fields collecting grain for food. God sent her to the field that belonged to Boaz. Boaz loved Ruth and rescued her from her trouble. Who does this remind us of? Who died on the Cross to rescue us from sin? *Jesus*.

LESSON 9

God chose Samuel! God called Samuel when he was only a boy. The Lord called him several times. Samuel thought it was Eli, the priest. God gave Samuel a hard job. He had to tell Eli that the Israelites would be judged for their sins. And then he told Eli that he and his family would be judged, too, because they disobeyed God. Samuel listened to the Lord and obeyed Him.

LESSON 10

The Israelites forgot about God. They rejected God as their King. They wanted a man to be their king so they could be like the other nations around them. So Saul was chosen to be the first king of Israel.

LESSON 11

Saul was the new king. God said there would be trouble and there was! The enemy was attacking! And then Saul did not obey God. He made a sacrifice to God, but he was supposed to wait for Samuel, the prophet. God wanted King Saul to obey. God took King Saul's kingdom away from him. God would make another man the next king!

LESSON 12

Saul disobeyed God. God had to choose someone else to be the next king. While seven of Jesse's sons passed by, God said, "No," to each one. God didn't look at the outside appearance or how big and strong they were. God looked at their hearts. Only David's heart pleased God. God wanted a king who would love and obey Him. God saw David's heart and chose David to be the next king.
