LESSON 7

Solomon built the Temple for God. Solomon loved God. He wanted to obey and build the special Temple where the people could come and worship the Lord. All the people worked very hard and did excellent work to make the Temple beautiful for the Lord. God was pleased with the Temple, and He sent His glory, like a cloud, into the Temple so the people would know He was with them.

LESSON 8

King Solomon's wisdom came from God. We can get wisdom from God's Word, the Bible. It tells us about God and is the only book we need to get real wisdom.

LESSON 9

Israel had many kings through the years. Those kings disobeyed God. They thought they were great! They had riches and power, and disobeyed God. When God is disobeyed, bad things happen. And we learned that King Rehoboam—who became king after Solomon—wouldn't listen and do the right thing. And because of that, the kingdom was split in two. There were now two nations and two kings. Jeroboam, Solomon's servant, was the king of Israel. And Rehoboam, Solomon's son, was the king of Judah.

LESSON 10

Jonah was a prophet of God. But when God told him to go speak to the people in the great city of Nineveh, Jonah ran the other way—he tried to outrun God! But God showed Him that He is in control. God used a boat, a big storm, and a big fish to show Jonah that he couldn't ever outrun God. That fish swallowed Jonah down then spit him back out. Jonah obeyed God and stopped trying to run from Him.

LESSON 11

The people in Israel were worshipping false gods. God used Elijah to show the false prophets and all the people that only God is the true, all powerful God. Elijah dared the prophets to pray to their false god and make fire come down on their altar. But nothing happened because they were praying to a god that wasn't real! But when Elijah prayed to our true God—wow! God sent fire down from the sky and showed everyone that He is the God we should worship.

LESSON 12

God chose Elijah to be his prophet. And he obeyed God. But God sent a chariot and horses of fire! And Elijah was gone! Now Elisha would take his place as prophet to the one true God!
