

Forever King Crown Pattern

Draw one or more (depending on the size of your class) large crowns onto butcher paper or poster board. Use the crown pattern below as a guide, if needed.

Students will decorate the crowns. Make one crown for every 4–5 students.

Supply the students with decorations—stickers, crayons, ribbon, buttons, sequins, etc.

Write “Jesus Is the Forever King!” on each crown you make.

Have the students decorate the crown(s) while explaining that Jesus was a descendant of David—part of David’s family. And He is the forever King. His kingdom will never end, just as God promised to David.
