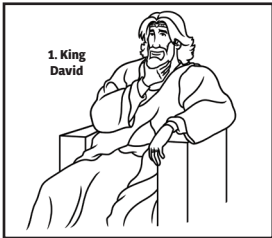


# Nathan's Story Role Play Script

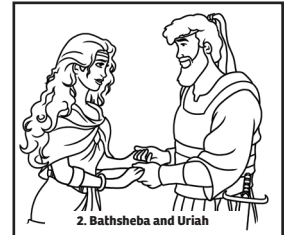

David was the king of all the land.



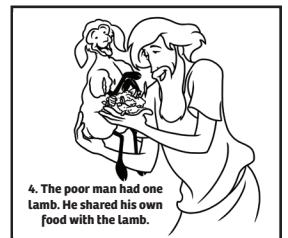

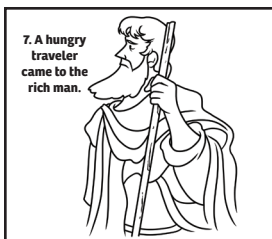
The story was about a rich man who had lots and lots of sheep.
