Review Script

Print one copy for use during the Come On In Activity. After children have colored the Lesson Review Coloring Sheets, they will tape them on the board as you call their numbers. Then describe briefly what occurred in the lesson. See script below.

LESSON 1

Goliath was a Philistine. He was big and mean, and an enemy of God. Everyone was afraid of him and didn't know how to fight him. But God gave David courage to fight and win—with a sling and a stone!

LESSON 2

God chose David to be the king of Israel. David loved the Lord—he had a heart after God. God made some special promises to David. He promised that David's son, Solomon, would be the next king and would build the beautiful Temple for the people to come and worship the Lord. But the best promise of all was that Jesus would one day be born and become the forever King!

LESSON 3

David disobeyed God. He took a man's wife and then had the man killed. God knew what David had done, didn't He? But God loved David and sent the prophet Nathan to tell him a story, so he would understand how wrong his sin was. The story was about the rich man and the poor man—and the poor man's lamb. David understood that the story was about him. David knew he had sinned against God. He asked God for His mercy and forgiveness.

LESSON 4

King David wrote lots of poems or songs to God, so we could praise and thank God. God wants us to sing praise to Him. He has done so much for us. He is the Creator of all things, and everything we have comes from Him. We should give Him thanks and praise for all He has done!

LESSON 5

King Solomon was a new king. He asked God for an understanding heart—wisdom—so he could be a good king. Solomon did not ask for riches or delicious food. He didn't ask for horses or gold or power. Solomon asked God for a heart of wisdom, which pleased God very much.
