

Kings Relay Scripture Sheet

Print one copy for your use during the Kings Relay Activity.

Relay Instructions: Place one each of the Good King and Bad King Pictures from the Resource DVD-ROM on the wall and have the students form two lines. Read the verses below. After you read each verse, students will determine if it was a good king or bad king. They will pick up a Good King or Bad King Sign and place it in front of the Good King and Bad King Pictures you have placed on the wall. Have the students walk backwards, skip, jump, hop, etc. to make the game more fun.

1 KINGS 14:9

⁹ But you [Jeroboam] have done more evil than all who were before you, for you have gone and made for yourself other gods and molded images to provoke Me to anger, and have cast Me behind your back.

1 KINGS 15:11

¹¹ Asa did what was right in the eyes of the Lord, as did his father David.

1 KINGS 15:26

²⁶ And he [Nadab] did evil in the sight of the Lord, and walked in the way of his father, and in his sin by which he had made Israel sin.

1 KINGS 15:34

³⁴ He [Baasha] did evil in the sight of the Lord, and walked in the way of Jeroboam, and in his sin by which he had made Israel sin.

1 KINGS 16:25

²⁵ Omri did evil in the eyes of the Lord, and did worse than all who were before him.

1 KINGS 16:30

³⁰ Now Ahab the son of Omri did evil in the sight of the Lord, more than all who were before him.

1 KINGS 22:43

⁴³ And he [Jehoshaphat] walked in all the ways of his father Asa. He did not turn aside from them, doing what was right in the eyes of the Lord. Nevertheless the high places were not taken away, for the people offered sacrifices and burned incense on the high places.

1 KINGS 22:52

⁵² He [Ahaziah] did evil in the sight of the Lord, and walked in the way of his father and in the way of his mother and in the way of Jeroboam the son of Nebat, who had made Israel sin.

2 KINGS 3:2

² And he [Jehoram] did evil in the sight of the Lord, but not like his father and mother; for he put away the sacred pillar of Baal that his father had made.

2 KINGS 10:31

³¹ But Jehu took no heed to walk in the law of the Lord God of Israel with all his heart; for he did not depart from the sins of Jeroboam, who had made Israel sin.

2 KINGS 12:2

² Jehoash did what was right in the sight of the Lord all the days in which Jehoiada the priest instructed him.

2 KINGS 14:3

³ And he [Amaziah] did what was right in the sight of the Lord, yet not like his father David; he did everything as his father Joash had done.

2 KINGS 15:3

³ And he [Azariah] did what was right in the sight of the Lord, according to all that his father Amaziah had done.

2 KINGS 15:18

¹⁸ And he [Menahem] did evil in the sight of the Lord; he did not depart all his days from the sins of Jeroboam the son of Nebat, who had made Israel sin.

2 KINGS 15:34

³⁴ And he [Jotham] did what was right in the sight of the Lord; he did according to all that his father Uzziah had done.

2 KINGS 16:2

² Ahaz was twenty years old when he became king, and he reigned sixteen years in Jerusalem; and he did not do what was right in the sight of the Lord his God, as his father David had done.

2 KINGS 18:3

³ And he [Hezekiah] did what was right in the sight of the Lord, according to all that his father David had done.

2 KINGS 24:19

¹⁹ He [Zedekiah] also did evil in the sight of the Lord, according to all that Jehoiakim had done.
