God Sent Assyria Activity Sheet

Print one copy for your use.

Divide the class into two "teams"—Assyria and the Israelites. Have them line up opposite each other. As you teach and sing the song, the students will act it out following the script below! Sing and act out each verse several times before moving on to the next verse and before putting the whole song together.

Continue to do it until the children can "perform" the play. Then allow them to switch parts.
