

Lesson Review Script

LESSON 7

Jesus taught the people some things that sounded different from what they had heard before. They knew that they should not murder or kill anybody. But Jesus did not even want them to be angry with others. In fact, Jesus wanted them to love their enemies instead of hating them. He said they should bless their enemies by being kind to them—and by praying for them, too! Jesus wants us to do the same. But we can only do it if we obey God from our heart and if we trust Jesus to help us.

LESSON 8

Passover was a holiday that the Jews celebrated every year. Many people would travel for days to Jerusalem where they could make sacrifices to God at the Temple. When Jesus came to the Temple during the Passover, He saw people there selling animals and men sitting at tables with stacks of money. They were not worshipping God. They were using the Temple as a place to make money. That's not what the Temple was for. Jesus wanted the people to treat His Father right, so He drove them out with their animals and their money. That did not belong in God's house.

LESSON 9

Jesus liked to use parables or short stories to teach some of His lessons. A parable is a story with a special meaning. He told the parable of the lost sheep. The lost sheep was like a lost sinner who needs to repent and turn to Jesus. The man who looked for his sheep was like Jesus who came to earth to seek and save the lost by dying on the Cross. And the friends who rejoiced when the man found his sheep are like those in heaven who rejoice when a person turns from his sin and turns to Jesus.

LESSON 10

Jesus wanted people to know the truth that He is God, the Great I Am. He often used ideas from simple things that the people already knew about. He called Himself the bread of life, the door, the light of the world, the good shepherd, the resurrection, the way, the truth, and the life. He talked about all these different things, but they all described Him. Jesus is the only one who can forgive us of our sins and give us eternal life with Him in heaven.

LESSON 11

Jesus said we are to love the Lord our God with all our heart, all our soul, and all our mind. Think about that! God wants us to love Him most of all—more than anything we have or anything we do! And when we want to love God this much, the things that are important to God will become more important to us, too. We won't love our stuff and our toys more than God.

LESSON 12

Jesus taught the people that He is God! He did miracles to show His power. His miracles were amazing! When Jesus taught, many people loved Him and believed what He said. He was God, and He was the Savior God promised to send. But not everyone loved Jesus! Some people got very angry at Him and even wanted to kill Him! They didn't like what He did or said. They did not believe in Jesus.
